RE: OPRA Request

Dear Mr. Kratovil:

I am in receipt of your email OPRA Request dated January 6, 2019 requesting the following information:

Under OPRA and the common law right of access, please provide documents, lists, reports or statements sufficient to show:

- 1) the name, title, department/division, current salary, and hire date for all salaried employees as of January 2, 2019
- 2) the name, title, department/division, current hourly rate, and hire date for all hourly employees as of January 2, 2019
- 3) the names of all employees currently enrolled in each healthcare insurance program/plan
- 4) the names of all employees currently enrolled in each public pension system
- 5) the names and pay status for each employee currently suspended from duty
- 6) the total 2018 base pay, overtime pay, and extra-duty pay for each employee

Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill because your request is asking for information not in our office which needs to be reviewed. OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled with the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P O Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by email at grc@dea.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
