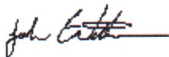
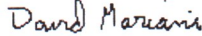

On the above date and time, I received a walk in at police headquarters from Mr. Harvey Clymer. Mr Clymer wanted to file a police report that someone broke into his house and stole his wallet and other items. While speaking with Mr. Clymer he stated that he believes that the person used a key to get into his apartment located at 304 Water street, Apartment D. He says there was no forced entry into the apartment and that roughly a month ago he had lost his apartment keys. Mr Clymer said he was swimming in the river by his apartment, he had his shirt and keys on top along the edge of the river and when he got back out his keys were gone. Mr. Clymer provided me with a few names that he may have taken his items. He suspected Cynthia Sandrue his neighbor, an acquaintance Anthony Crowell who he has recent just met, and a friend Simon and his girlfriend Elaina who are homeless and their mother reside at 306 Water street. Mr. Clymer suspects Cynthia due to each of them battling back and fourth over issues and Cynthia always calling the police on him. The next person Mr. Clymer listed was Mr. Anthony Crowell, who he has only known for roughly the past month. Mr. Clymer says he has not seen Anthony around lately, the last time he was seen was November 7th when he was last over his apartment. Mr. Clymer says he has OCD and everything is laid out around the apartment for organization and when Anthony was over he would not sit still and kept touching everything which made him uneasy and asked him to leave his apartment. Mr. Clymer states that he lost his wallet and a small clear orange bag that had a large amount of miscellaneous cards in it. He was unable to provide all the names of the cards. He also mentioned that there was no money on any of the cards as he was currently broke. I provided a property loss form and advised him to take it home and when he remembered things to write them down. Mr. Clymer left headquarters, no further action taken by patrol, case was referred to Detective for further investigation in to the matter.

78. Narrative On November 29, 2024, I was dispatched to 310 Front Street, Belvidere, NJ 07823 for a theft in progress. Dispatch advised parties were attempting to steal scaffolding from behind the building and the caller was preventing them to leave in their vehicle. Upon arrival, Sgt. Mariani was on location. He gathered information from the two male parties involved and requested dispatch to check them for warrants. A female, identified as Kristy Clymer was in the rear passenger seat of the vehicle. I gathered her information and also requested dispatch to check her for warrants. The two male parties, identified as Randall Oakley and John Morris advised that the male resident of apartment D told them that they could take the scaffolding. They stated they needed it for a construction project at their home in Stroudsburg, PA. The resident, who I am familiar with from other incidents, is identified as Harvey Clymer. Mr. Clymer is the brother of Kristy Clymer. Mr. Oakley stated he has known the family for years. The caller and landlord, Allen Kumetz, stated that his wife saw them on the cameras, so he went back there. He witnessed them attempting to put the scaffolding on top of Mr. Oakley's 2001 Jeep. When he told them that they could not take it and Mr. Clymer was not the owner of the material, they put it back. Mr. Kumetz did not want to press charges on the individuals. I attempted to make contact with Mr. Clymer, who would not come outside of his residence.

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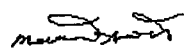

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Dispatch then advised that Randall Oakley had one ATS and one ACS warrant out of Raritan Township Police Department. Both warrants were for \$501.00. I placed Mr. Oakley under arrest and explained that he was under arrest on the warrants. He was then placed in the back of my marked patrol unit 2113. I transported Mr. Oakley from 310 Front Street to headquarters located at 691 Water Street while Sgt. Mariani waited on the return of the other two parties.

Kristy Clymer and the male who identified himself as John Morris did not have warrants. Dispatch was unable to locate identification for John Morris with the date of birth he provided. Mr. Oakley was okay with leaving his vehicle with the parties.

Raritan Township Police Department was contacted. They advised they would lodge Mr. Oakley on the warrants. I then transported Mr. Oakley from headquarters to McDonald's located at 185 Center Street, Clinton, NJ 08809. Custody of Mr. Oakley was transferred to Officer Villa of Raritan Township Police Department without incident. Patrol cleared.
