While on motor patrol in marked unit 48 on the morning of Friday, September 13, 2024 at approximately 1014 hours, Desk Officer Sinatra #134 requested S.O. Riedel #216 (marked unit 45) and I meet the Bergen County Prosecutors Office- Cyber Crimes Task Force at 699 Jacquelyn Road in our jurisdiction to assist with a knock and talk. Due to the nature of the visit by the BCPO Cyber Crimes Task Force, Detective Yousef Fattah and Task Force Investigator Luscombe requested two uniformed officers assist them with the meeting. Upon arriving at 699 Jacquelyn Rd, we were met by the mother of the subject in question. We requested to speak with Mr. Benjamin Ritter in regards to their investigation. Upon Speaking to Mr. Ritter, the BCPO Task Force officers advised him of why they were there, and proceeded to ask Mr. Ritter if his phone was present, which he replied his phone was in his room. I then went with Mr. Ritter to his bedroom to retrieve his phone. Once in his bedroom, he could not locate the iPhone, he then went into the bathroom where he located the phone. We then proceeded back downstairs to the BCPO Task Force Officers who were waiting on the front steps. The Bergen County Prosecutors Office Cyber Crimes Task force then secured the Apple iPhone 13 with a brown leather case to preserve any evidence which may be contained on it due to their reasonable suspicion that the iPhone may contain contraband on it. The phone was placed into airplane mode to prevent any remote access and Mr. Ritter was provided with a receipt for the phone by the Bergen County Prosecutors Office.

While on motor patrol in marked unit #47 on Sunday, April 13, 2025 I was parked on Meisten Street facing Washington Avenue, observing the Pascack Road and Washington Avenue intersection. At approximately 0202 hours, I observed a grey Genesis GV80 (Bearing NJ Reg. D56DUY) traveling northbound on Pascack Road and initiated a left hand turn from Pascack Road onto westbound Washington Avenue. When the vehicle turned onto Washington Avenue the operator began driving on the wrong side of the roadway, into oncoming eastbound traffic. The operator of the vehicle corrected course, abruptly steering into the right lane of travel. Upon the vehicle passing my marked patrol unit on Meisten Street, I pulled behind the vehicle, activated my emergency overhead lights/siren and conducted a motor vehicle stop on Jacquelyn Road, north of Washington Avenue.

I radioed to Dispatcher Cassidy of my motor vehicle stop, and conducted a driver's side approach to the vehicle. I immediately observed the operator had red and watery eyes. I informed the operator of the vehicle, Mr. Benjamin P. Ritter (who shall be further referred to as the defendant), our interaction was being video and audio recorded on my department issued body worn camera (Reference CAD as my body worn camera malfunctioned). I informed the defendant of the probable cause for the motor vehicle stop was his inability to keep right on the roadway. I requested the defendant provide me with his driver's license, registration and valid proof of insurance for the vehicle. The defendant informed me he was driving his mother's car and would be unable to locate the vehicle's registration or valid proof of insurance. At this time there was an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from inside of the vehicle. I asked the defendant if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages that would impair his ability to operate a motor vehicle. The defendant responded by stating he had consumed three beers at Dave and Busters earlier in the night. The defendant later provided me with his driver's license, and I informed him to remain in his vehicle while I validated his information in my marked patrol unit. Corporal Ferrarini #131 (Marked unit #52) arrived on scene.

After informing Cpl. Ferrarini of my observations we re-approached the vehicle taking a driver's side approach and requested the defendant step out of the vehicle in order to conduct standardized field sobriety testing. I escorted the defendant to the front of my marked patrol unit and informed him Cpl. Ferrarini would be conducting the tests. Upon his response I smelled an odor of an alcoholic beverage on the defendant's breath.

Cpl. Ferrarini advised the defendant the first test would be the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) test. Cpl. Ferrarini instructed the defendant to stand with his feet together and his hands at his side. Cpl. Ferrarini confirmed the defendant had no medical conditions,...

9. I repeat, the law requires you to submit samples of your breath for testing. Will you submit the samples of your breath?

If a court finds you guilty of the refusal, you will be subject to various penalties, including license revocation of up to 20 years, a fine of up to \$2000, installation of an ignition interlock, and referral to an Intoxicated Driver Resource Center. These penalties may be in addition to penalties imposed by the court for any other offense of which you are found guilty.

3. A record of the taking of the samples, including the date, time and results, will be made. Upon your request, a copy of that record will be made available to you.
4. Any warnings previously given to you concerning your right to remain silent and your right to consult with an attorney do not apply to the taking of breath samples and do not give you the right to refuse to give, or to delay giving, samples of your breath for the purposes of making chemical tests to determine your alcohol concentration. You have no legal right to have an attorney, physician, or anyone else present, for the purpose of taking the breath samples.
5. After you have provided samples of your breath for chemical testing, you have the right to have a person or physician of your own selection, and at your own expense, take independent samples and conduct independent chemical tests of your breath, urine, or blood.
6. If you refuse to give samples of your breath you will be issued a separate summons for this refusal.
7. Any response that is ambiguous or conditional, in any respect, to your giving consent to the taking of breath samples will be treated as a refusal to submit to breath testing.
8. According to N.J.S.A. 39:3-10.24f, if a court of law finds you guilty of refusing to submit to chemical tests of your breath, then your license to operate any motor vehicle will be revoked by the court for a period of no less than six months and no more than two years. The Court will also fine you a sum of no less than \$250 and no more than \$500 for your refusal conviction.
9. If a court of law finds you guilty of refusing to submit to chemical tests of your breath, and you were operating a commercial motor vehicle, then your commercial driver license will be suspended by the court for a period of no less than one and no more than three years. If your refusal conviction is in connection with operating a commercial motor vehicle transporting hazardous material or displaying a hazardous material placard, then your commercial driver license will be suspended for three years. If your refusal conviction is in connection with a second or subsequent violation of any of the offenses specified at N.J.S.A. 39:3-10.20a, the Court will revoke your commercial driver license for life.
10. Any license suspension or revocation for a refusal conviction will be independent to any license suspension or revocation imposed for any related offense.
11. If you are convicted of refusing to submit to chemical tests of your breath, you must also satisfy the requirements of a program of alcohol education or rehabilitation.
12. I repeat, you are required by law to submit to the taking of samples of your breath for the purpose of making chemical tests to determine your alcohol concentration. Now, will you give the samples of your breath?

injuries, or eye problems which would prevent him from completing the test, although the defendant did state he was tired. Cpl. Ferrarini and I ensured the defendant was on flat and level ground, facing away from any flashing lights. Cpl. Ferrarini using the tip of his pen as the stimulus, held the pen 12-15 inches from the defendant's eyes and slightly above eye level. He instructed the defendant to follow the stimulus with just his eyes while he checked for equal pupil size and equal tracking in both eyes. After Cpl. Ferrarini concluded the HGN test he informed me he observed four out of six clues from the defendant indicating intoxication or use of drugs.

Cpl. Ferrarini informed the defendant the second test would be the Walk and Turn (WAT) test. The defendant faced south bound in the roadway and was placed in the starting position, left heel touching his right toe and hands at his sides. He instructed the defendant to take nine heel to toe steps in a line, turn around using a small series of steps and take nine more heel to toe steps back. After Cpl. Ferrarini demonstrated the test, again the defendant was advised of the instructions and to keep his hands at his side while counting his step out loud. The defendant conducted the test as demonstrated.

Cpl. Ferrarini advised the defendant the third test would be the One Leg Stand (OLS). The defendant was instructed to stand with his feet flat together and his hands at his sides. He was placed in the starting position and instructed to raise one leg, of his choosing, approximately six inches from the roadway, stare at his foot and count out loud. After Cpl. Ferrarini demonstrated the test, he informed the defendant he can begin the test. The defendant conducted the test as demonstrated. I instructed the defendant sit back in his vehicle while I conferred with Cpl. Ferrarini to discuss our observations further. Sgt. Gugger #125 (Marked unit #43) arrived on scene.

Due to my observations in the HGN tests (Four out of six clues), the defendant's bloodshot, watery eyes, odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from his breathe and driving behavior, I believed the defendant was impaired due to drugs or alcohol. I re-approached the vehicle and requested the defendant step out and I escorted him to the rear of his vehicle. I requested the defendant face away from me and put his hands behind his back, as he was placed under arrest for 39:4-50 (Driving while intoxicated). The defendant was placed in handcuffs, double locked behind his back and searched incident to arrest. The property found on the defendant's person was placed in an evidence bag and secured in marked patrol unit #52. He was escorted to the passenger side rear door of marked patrol unit #52 and placed inside the vehicle, with his seatbelt and harness secured. The rear passenger seat of marked patrol unit #52 was checked for contraband or weapons prior to placing the defendant in the vehicle, which yielded negative results. At this time I read the defendant his Miranda Warning which he acknowledged he understood.

I returned to the defendant's vehicle and conducted a search for the vehicle's registration and valid proof of insurance. Cpl. Ferrarini located the vehicle's registration and valid proof of insurance in the center console. Upon returning to my marked patrol unit I inputted the defendant's NJ driver's license into our INFOCOP system, which had a return showing his license was suspended. Cpl. Ferrarini asked the defendant if he knew his license was suspended, which he acknowledged he did and claimed the reason for suspension was for 39:6B-2 (No Liability Insurance for Motor Vehicle). Disp. Cassidy later confirmed the reason for the defendant's suspended license was for not obtaining liability insurance for a different vehicle. Disp. Cassidy also informed us roadside the defendant did not have any active ATS or ACS warrants.

Sgt. Gugger remained on scene awaiting Emerson Towing (89 Woodland Avenue, Westwood, NJ, 07675). Cpl. Ferrarini and I began transport of the defendant to Westwood Police Department (101 Washington Avenue, Westwood, NJ, 07675) to obtain breath samples. Cpl. Ferrarini radioed to Disp. Cassidy informing him of his starting mileage and the defendant was monitored during transport via the in car camera while I followed in marked unit #47.

Upon arrival at Westwood PD Cpl. Ferrarini radioed to Disp. Cassidy of his ending mileage. Cpl. Ferrarini and I secured our firearms in weapons lockers #1 and #2. I escorted the defendant out of the rear passenger seat of marked patrol unit #52 and placed him in the holding area of Westwood PD. The rear passenger area was checked for any contraband with negative results. At this time I removed the handcuffs from behind the defendant's back and observed him for a 20 minute period confirming he did not eat, drink, burp, regurgitate or spit for the duration of the observation. During this time Cpl. Ferrarini advised the defendant once again of his Miranda Warning which he acknowledged he understood and completed the drinking and driving questionnaire.

When the 20 minute observation was complete Cpl. Ferrarini and I removed all electronics from our person including cell phones, wrist watches, portable radios and key fobs. Cpl. Ferrarini read the defendant the standard statement form, at which time the defendant agreed to provide samples of his breath. The defendant was escorted to the Alcotest room and stood adjacent to the Alcotest machine. After all pertinent information was entered into the system, the Alcotest machine ran a control check and a prompt of 'PLEASE BLOW/R' was received. Cpl. Ferrarini placed a new,

sealed/unopened mouthpiece on the Alcotest hose and handed it to the defendant. He instructed the defendant to take a deep breath and blow into the mouthpiece with one continuous breath and continue blowing until he instructed him to stop. The defendant acknowledged he understood the instructions and provided a valid breath sample. Upon the machine prompting 'PLEASE BLOW/R' for a second breath sample, Cpl. Ferrarini replaced the mouth piece with a new, sealed/unopened mouthpiece and handed the Alcotest hose back to the defendant. Cpl. Ferrarini repeated the same instructions from the previous breath sample to which the defendant acknowledged and provided a second valid breath sample. The defendant was placed back in the holding area while the data from the Alcotest was entered into the CJIS calculator and received a passing certification. The Alcotest results collected a BAC of .09%. I placed the defendant back into handcuffs, behind his back and double locked them for transport back to our police headquarters. He was placed back into the rear passenger seat of marked patrol unit #52. The rear passenger seat of marked patrol unit #52 was checked for contraband or weapons prior to placing the defendant into the vehicle, which yielded negative results. Cpl. Ferrarini radioed to Disp. Cassidy informing him of his starting mileage back to police headquarters.

After arriving at our police headquarters Cpl. Ferrarini radioed to Disp. Cassidy his ending mileage and the defendant was escorted inside, searched incident to arrest and placed in holding cell #1. The rear passenger seat of marked patrol unit #52 was again checked for contraband or weapons which yielded negative results. Before placing the defendant in holding cell #1 Cpl. Ferrarini and I secured our firearms in weapons lockers #1 and #2. Cpl. Ferrarini went through the jail cell questionnaire with the defendant, and after doing so allowed him to make a phone call to attempt to make contact with a sober party with a valid drivers license who would be willing to sign the John's Law Waiver, in which the party would take responsibility for the defendant. The defendant was able to make contact with Mr. Norman C. Bellion and he agreed to respond to police headquarters to assume responsibility of the defendant.

Upon Mr. Bellion's arrival at police headquarters, I informed him of the John's Law Waiver form which he acknowledged and signed. I informed Mr. Bellion he would have to stay with the defendant ensuring he did not drive another motor vehicle until 0600 hours. At this time I escorted the defendant out of cell #1 and into the judges chambers in our police headquarters. I informed him of the four summonses I was issuing him and provided him with his property back. The defendant acknowledged all of his belongings were accounted for and signed the property sheet. I also informed the defendant the summonses would require his appearance in court, and advised him if he had scheduling difficulties with the scheduled court date and time to contact the court administrator. Lastly, I informed the defendant a valid driver would have to respond to police headquarters at or after 1500 hours on Sunday, April 13, 2025 in order for us to release the vehicle from Emerson Towing. The defendant gathered his property and was released to Mr. Bellion.

The John's Law Waiver form, Alcotest results/CJIS calculator results, cell log form, and property sheet were uploaded to the electronic case file.

On Sunday, April 13, 2025 at approximately 1523 hours, Ms. Beth Ritter responded to police headquarters, provided her valid NJ drivers license and the vehicle was released from impound at Emerson Towing.
