On 11/09/2024 at 0718 hours I, Ptl. Summerton, was dispatched to 221 Butler Blvd for a report of a White Hyundai going 100mph down his road. At the same time, another call was received where the caller, Mr. Manuel Vieira, stated that a man, Mr. Nicholas Kyriakopoulos, had approached him and stated that a white vehicle with two males in it had broken into his residence.

Upon my arrival at 221 Butler Boulevard, I spoke with the initial caller, Michael Musto (221 Butler Blvd [REDACTED]). Mr. Musto reiterated that he observed a White Honda going 100mph down Butler Blvd. Subsequently, I spoke with the victim Mr. Kyriakopoulos. While at 221 Butler Boulevard, Mr. Kyriakopoulos was able to inform me that an individual had attempted to burglarize his vehicle. Mr. Kyriakopoulos stated that the unidentified thin male was wearing all black, black hoodie, and had a really fine mustache. In addition, he provided a photo and video of the escape vehicle which showed a White Honda Accord bearing NJ Registration X85UGR.

With this information, I ran the registration and pulled up the registered owner's driver's license photo (Mr. Connor Lothrop). After reviewing the photo, I asked Mr. Kyriakopoulos if he got a good look at the male. In response, Mr. Kyriakopoulos walked towards my patrol vehicle stating yes. As soon as he approached he observed the photo I had pulled up and immediately stated " Yes that's 90% him". At this time, Mr. Kyriakopoulos was instructed to head back to his residence so an investigation could take place. It should be noted that I did not inform Mr. Kyriakopoulos who the individual was before he recognized him.

Shortly after arriving at 70 Harbor Inn Road, Mr. Kyriakopoulos was asked to recall the incidents that occurred. He stated that this morning he woke up around 0705 for a haircut. While performing his morning routine his wife, Ms. Kathleen M Kyriakopoulos, informed him that she saw legs coming out of her vehicle. In response, Mr. Kyriakopoulos walked to his living room where he could clearly see Mr. Lothrop in their vehicle. It should be known that their vehicle was parked approximately 10 feet away from the living room window. In addition to how close the vehicle was, their living room window allowed Mr. Kyriakopoulos a clear and unobstructed vantage point into the vehicle. It was at this time that Mr. Kyriakopoulos obtained the above description of Mr. Lothrop.

After confirming that his wife's statements were true, Mr. Kyriakopoulos exited his residence and yelled at Mr. Lothrop. According to Mr. Kyriakopoulos, Mr. Lothrop exited their vehicle and ran East on Harbor Inn Road. Mr. Kyriakopoulos attempted to chase him, however, knew that he would not be able to keep up. At this time, Mr. Kyriakopoulos ran back to his house, got his car keys, and attempted to relocate Mr. Lothrop. With no success, Mr. Kyriakopoulos stopped to speak with a male, Mr. Manuel Vieira [REDACTED], who was working on his car in front of 162 Brennan Concourse. Mr. Kyriakopoulos informed Mr. Vieira of the incident and asked if he had seen Mr. Lothrop. Fortunately, Mr. Vieira was able to provide valued information that he had seen the above-described male walking towards Harbor Inn Road. At this time, both Mr. Kyriakopoulos and Mr. Vieira searched for Mr. Lothrop.

While driving around, Mr. Viera informed Mr. Kyriakopoulos that he saw Mr. Lothrop enter a white vehicle and head East on Harbor Inn Road. In hopes of further identifying the male and vehicle, Mr. Kyriakopoulos drove down Harbor Inn Road. Luckily, Mr. Kyriakopoulos spotted the white vehicle as it turned down the dead-end part of the road on Brennan Concourse. At this time, Mr. Kyriakopoulos partially blocked the vehicle allowing himself to capture a clear picture of the vehicle's license plate. According to Mr. Kyriakopoulos, the vehicle then turned onto Neary Ave, also a dead end, where it stopped and the driver exited the vehicle. Mr. Kyriakopoulos saw the driver open his rear driver-side door, appear to look for something, and then get back into the car. However, Mr. Viera stated that he saw the driver switch seats with another male who took control of the vehicle.

After the vehicle was re-entered, it was driven in reverse into a curb at the intersection of Nearly Ave and Brennan Concourse. Subsequently, the vehicle took off down Brennan Concourse towards Butler Blvd. According to Mr.

Kyriakopoulos, it was at this time that he lost the vehicle, but he eventually met the initial caller at 221 Butler Blvd while searching the area.

The area was checked for cameras with negative results. After the initial investigation, finger prints were discovered on the vehicle where Mr. Kyriakopoulos saw Mr. Lothrop run from. As a result, Detective Williams from the Berkeley Township Police Department was contacted and responded to the scene (See supplement report for further information). At this report's time, Mr. Kyriakopoulos and Ms. Kyriakopoulos stated that nothing was missing from their vehicle. A victim notification form was filled out for Ms. Kyriakopoulos and Mr. Lothrop was placed on warrant # 1505 W 2024 000378 for 2C:5-1A(1) and 2C:18-2A(1) (NIC# W840488792).

On 11/09/2024 at 1126 hours I, Ptl. Summerton, was dispatched to 8 Key Largo Ct for a report of a Motor Vehicle burglary. Upon my arrival, I spoke with the victim Ms. Jessica Collum.

Ms. Collum stated that on 11/08/2024, she returned home around 1630 hours. When she exited her vehicle, she left it unlocked and kept her wallet and card holder inside. This morning, at 0900 hours, she received a notification on her phone from one of her Capitol One cards. This alert notified Ms. Collum that a purchase was made at Advance Auto Parts for \$28.78.

Ms. Collum knowing that she did not purchase anything from Advance Auto Parts, contacted her credit card and figured that she got hacked. After talking with Capitol One, she reported that the credit card was hacked and requested that the card company freeze the account. A short time later, she received another charge on the same card that was blocked. However, Mr. Collum became suspicious when another unauthorized purchase came through on her Apple Card. At this time, Ms. Collum went outside to her vehicle (bearing NJ Registration R88KPL) and realized some of her belongings were gone. Subsequently, Ms. Collum checked the cameras and discovered she was a victim of a motor vehicle burglary. The following items were stolen from her vehicle:

sweatshirt, black sweat pants with a light color line, a black ski mask, and white and black Nike shoes. In the video, the suspect can be seen checking several vehicles to see if their doors are unlocked. At 0652 hours, the suspect opens Ms. Collum`s vehicle and enters it through the passenger side door. At 0653 hours, the male can be seen exiting the vehicle with the white envelope and several items stuffed into his sweatshirt pocket.

In addition, the surveillance footage captured the male touching Ms. Collum`s passenger side door several times without gloves on. As a result, Detective Williams from the Berkeley Township Police Department responded to the scene. While on the scene, Det. Williams successfully lifted fingerprints off of Ms. Collum`s vehicle door and her husband`s vehicle door hand (See Det. Williams` Supplement report for further information).

At this time, Ms. Collum is out of the items above, totaling an estimated value of \$3,135.27 (the price includes the check for \$2500.00). Ms. Collum was given a report number and a completed victim notification form. All surveillance footage and transaction receipts were uploaded to evidence.com. The area was canvassed for further evidence, however, it yielded negative results. It should be known that another motor vehicle burglary was committed in the area around 0700 hours (see report 24-003301 for further information).

Nothing further to report at this time.

On November 15, 2024 at approximately 1544 hours I, Ptl. Scaturro, responded to 431 Rt 9, Bayville, NJ 08721 (ShopRite) for a shoplifting incident that occurred on November 6, 2024. I made contact with the lost prevention manager, Edward Zawada Jr., who advised me that he has surveillance footage of a female shoplifting \$140.91 worth of miscellaneous items.

I reviewed the surveillance footage from ShopRite which shows the female placing multiple items inside of her shopping cart and proceed to leave the store without paying. The surveillance camera's show the female enter a white Jeep Cherokee bearing NJ reg J51PGG. That vehicle came back to a Kevin Penn out of 1802 Iger Way, Bayville, NJ 08721. Ptl. Dedeyn and I responded to that address in an attempt to identify the female. Upon our arrival we made contact with the female who was identified as Danielle Penn. I was able to confirm that Mrs. Penn was the female shoplifter through surveillance footage.

Mrs. Penn was placed under arrest with her hands behind her back utilizing the double locking mechanism. Mrs. Penn was secured in the rear prisoner compartment of patrol vehicle 578 and seatbelted. It should be noted that two sets of handcuffs were utilized on Mrs. Penn due to her having complaints of shoulder pain from an unrelated incident. Mrs. Penn was searched prior to transport yielding negative results. The rear prisoner compartment of vehicle 578 was searched prior to and after transport yielding negative results. Mrs. Penn was transported to the Berkeley Township Police Department without issue.
