On 01/06/2025 I Sergeant Casterioto was dispatched by central communications to the area of 201 1st Avenue for the report of a suspicious male knocking on doors. Central communications gave me the description of the suspect as a thin white male wearing a blue jacket.

Upon my arrival to the area, I observed a male knocking at the door of [REDACTED] Clarence Avenue that matched the description given by central communications. The homeowner was just opening the door for the male when I began making contact. The homeowner advised the did not wish to speak with the male so I then asked him to step off the property to speak with me. The male was identified as Ian Addis who provided a work identification card from [REDACTED]. I asked Addis if he had a permit to solicited in Berlin Township. Addis stated he did not, but he just started working for this company. Addis was advised that in Berlin Township he had to have a permit to solicit and that he was in violation without one. A short time later a male identified as Daimon Higgins arrived on location and stated he worked for the same company. Higgins advised he was a supervisor role with the company. Higgins was advised that Addis would be issued a summons for soliciting without a permit and that the company needs to know to not solicit within our town without a permit. Addis was advised the summons would be mailed to his house.

On 01/20/2025 I issued Addis for violation of Berlin Township local ordinance 239-3a on summons #0406SC00 [REDACTED] with a Berlin Township court date of 02/27/2025 at 8am. The summons was mailed to Addis's residence of [REDACTED].

78. Narrative
This report is a summary of my recollection of this event. More detailed information may be found on my department issued body camera footage.

On December 18, 2024 at approximately 13:55 hours patrols were dispatched to Berlin Township police headquarters for a walk in. Upon arrival, I spoke with Home depot loss prevention employee Brett Watson (DOB: [REDACTED]) who wish to report a shoplifting that occurred on 12/13/24. Mr. Watson advised a male who he has identified as from previous shopliftings at other Home Depots in the area, entered the Home Depot (116 Walker Avenue West Berlin, NJ 08091) through the main entrance on December 13, 2024 at approximately 10:33 am with an empty flatbed cart. The suspect identified as James Keane (DOB: [REDACTED]) then proceeds to select (5) Dewalt Atomic 20v combo sets, totaling in value of \$745.00 and loads them onto the flatbed cart. At approximately 10:40 am, Mr. Keane exits the main entrance, passing all points of sale without rendering payment. Mr. Keane was then seen on CCTV loading the stolen merchandise into a silver color sedan. Mr. Keane gets into the passenger side front seat and the vehicle drives away towards Walker Avenue. No license plate information gathered.

Mr. Watson later provided me with CCTV footage, which I was able to observe and confirm the statements made by Mr. Watson. Utilizing Camden County RMS, I was able to confirm that the male was in fact James W. Keane (DOB: [REDACTED]) by comparing CCTV footage and photos of Mr. Keane linked in RMS in which he was the suspect involved in numerous shopliftings where he uses the same modius operandi. On January 18, 2025 upon watching the CCTV footage, I found probable cause to charge Mr. Keane with the following.
