78. Narrative The following statement is based on my recollection of the event. For further information, please see my BWC footage. On December 25th, 2024, at 14:38 hours, I, Ptl. Garrison #55 of the BTPD responded to the Shell Gas Station, located at 899 Rt-73, for the report of theft of gas. Upon my arrival, I met with the employee Ismail Azgin. It should be noted that there is a significant language barrier. Azgin attempted to explain from what I gathered that a male handed him 3 fake \$20 bills as payment for \$60.00 worth of gas. He then demonstrated that he attempted to stop the driver, who then took off towards Rt-73. It should be noted that the \$20 bills were clearly marked for "motion picture use only". It should also be noted that the suspect did receive \$60.00 worth a gas without rendering true payment. I then spoke with Edward Naulty Jr. who advised he was a witness/the caller and had footage of the incident. It should also be noted that Naulty was able to take a photo of the suspect vehicle bearing NJ Temp. [REDACTED], which came back expired on a silver 2002 Jeep Grand Cherokee. The suspect vehicle was an older model dark blue Chevy Silverado. Naulty then showed me the footage, where I observed a light skinned male, approximately mid to late 30's, wearing a baseball cap sitting in the driver seat of the suspect vehicle. It did not appear as if anyone else was inside of the vehicle, however, the quality of the footage became very pixilated when zoomed in. I then observed the driver pull away at a faster rate of speed and Azgin chase the vehicle holding the fictitious money. The driver then drove over the curb and entered onto Rt-73 northbound. Naulty then advised that the vehicle turned off onto East Collins Ave

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and lost visual of the vehicle. It should be noted that Azgin could not get the camera footage to work for Shell Gas Station. I then took possession of the 3 fictious \$20.00 bills and placed them inside the BTPD temporary evidence lockers, located at 135 Rt-73. Once I returned to headquarters, I attempted to look into the temp registration and see if the registered owner matched the male observed in the video. Which came back to a 78-year-old male that did not match the male observed on the video. I did not observe any related cases where another male matching that description was involved with that registered owner either possibly linking the two together. Yeilding negative results as to a possible suspect. Unknown actor. The video has been uploaded to axon under this case number. Closed.
