78. Narrative On 05/31/2024 I Sergeant Casterioto was dispatched to the Home Depot for the report of a shoplifting that had occurred but the suspect ran off. Central communications advised that loss prevention was able to recover the proceeds. Upon my arrival I met with Home Depots loss prevention employee identified as Dexter Miller. Miller advised that about 10 minutes prior a white male attempted to shoplift numerous tools by pushing the out of the store in a shopping cart. Miller advised that prior to the male leaving the store he stopped him and was able to recover the shopping cart full of unpaid tools. Miller advised the male then ran out of the store and was last seen on foot towards Walker Avenue. As I was speaking with Miller he was accessing Home Depots surveillance cameras. Miller brought up a picture of the suspect which depicted a bald white male with tattoos on his right arm, wearing a gray shirt, and dark shorts. Miller provided a receipt for the stolen good that he recovered in the amount of \$571.71. Miller was advised that I was going to email him an axon link to upload the video footage from Home Depot. I left Home Depot and began checking along Walker Avenue for someone matching the description of the suspect. Eventually I pulled into the parking lot of Sprinklz Ice Cream shop to send Miller the axon link. When I pulled in I was behind two vehicles parked in the lot. A white male got out of the drivers seat of the black Volvo, walked around, and entered in to the driver seat of a black pick up truck. The male resembled the suspect from the Shoplifting but at this time I did not have a picture with me to confirm. I began calling Miller to send a picture of the suspect to the supervisor cell phone so I could confirm if it was the suspect. As I was doing so the male began to leave in the black pickup truck bearing NJ registration [REDACTED]. This same registration was relayed to central communications via the radio. At this time my intentions were to obtain a picture on the supervisor cellphone from Miller, confirm if it was the

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same male I just observed in the parking lot, and if it was stop the vehicle and make an arrest for the same. The black pickup truck then jumped into traffic on Haddon Avenue. I pulled onto Haddon Avenue a few vehicles behind the suspect. I lost visual on the vehicle for a very short period of time but then saw it driving at a fast rate of speed down Jefferson Avenue towards the dead end. At this time I received the picture on the supervisor cell phone and confirmed it was the same male that I saw in the parking lot. At this point and time I believed that the suspects vehicle was going to park at one of the houses on the street. As I was driving down Jefferson Avenue I was checking all of the driveways, checking for the suspects vehicle. Once I got to the last house without seeing the vehicle the owner of the house came outside and advised that the suspects vehicle drove past her residence at a high rate of speed and went into the woods at the dead end. The trail leading into the woods was followed but there was no sight of the suspects vehicle. It was determined that the trail leads to numerous roads in Voorhees off of Lafayette Avenue that the suspect must have utilized to get away.

When running the registration for the vehicle it came back to a William Dowell with a birth date of [REDACTED]. The male I observed driver was younger than 64 years old so I began investigating see if there was documentation of another male driving the same vehicle. While checking RMS I found that the same pick up truck bearing NJ registration [REDACTED] was stopped by Voorhees Police Department on 01/10/2024 where a James Gesicki was the driver. Utilizing my MDT I ran Gesickis driver license number [REDACTED] which showed a 36 year old while male. The drivers license picture matched the male I saw in the parking lot of Sprinklz that was driving the pick up truck and the suspect from Home Depot. James Gesicki Jr. was identified as the suspect for this case.

I returned to Sprinklz and observed that the black Volvo I observed Gesicki exiting was gone. I then made contact with the owner of the business named Bruce. Bruce was able to pull up video footage from his surveillance cameras that were all around the exterior of the building. The video was re-winded back to the time when I observed Gesicki in the parking lot. Just prior to both of our arrival the video showed a blonde female pull up and park the black pickup bearing the Nj registration of [REDACTED]. The female exits the vehicle and goes up to the ice cream shop and orders a product. In the meanwhile Gesicki arrives in the black Volvo, gets out of the vehicle, and gets into the black pickup ([REDACTED]). In the video you can see Gesicki leave the parking lot with me leaving shortly thereafter. The female who is now on the phone gets into the black Volvo and drives away. Unfortunately we were unable to make out the registration on the black Volvo from the video. It was apparent the female was helping Gesicki by driving there and swapping vehicles with him. The black Volvo is suspected to be what Gesicki used to drive away from Home Depot after attempting to shoplift the items.

On 06/06/2024 I charged Gesicki with 2C:20-11b(1)(shoplifting) placed on summons #0406S2024000[REDACTED] with a CJP court date of 07/05/2024. The summons will be mailed to Gisickis last known address of [REDACTED] Id, [REDACTED], NJ 08008. Gesicki was also issued a motor vehicle summons for reckless/careless for driving down Jefferson Avenue at a high rate of speed. These summons were mailed with the criminal complaint to the same address.

Case closed pending court or anything further identification of the female involved. Case can be reopened at that time if needed.

78. Narrative

The following is a report of the incident to the best of my recollection. Refer to body worn camera footage for further details.

On June 1, 2024 Berlin Township Police officers were dispatched to Home Depot (116 Walker Ave, West Berlin, NJ 08091) for a report of a shoplifting. Upon arrival, Sgt. Casterioto #41 advised me over the radio that the suspect had fled the store just before he entered. At that time, I was also approached by the complainant, Dexter Miller, who stated that the suspect got into a vehicle and fled the area. He showed me a video of the suspect vehicle, which was a Gray Ford Explorer with numerous stickers on the rear windshield and stated that it fled towards Route 73. I then turned my patrol vehicle around to circulate the area and observed the vehicle driving near the Saladworks (200 NJ-73, West Berlin, NJ 08091). I utilized my overhead emergency lights and sirens to attempt to close the distance with the fleeing vehicle. The vehicle was then observed turning onto Minck Ave, where I was able to get behind it. The vehicle (NJ - [REDACTED]) slowly came to a stop at the intersection of Grove Ave & Cleveland Ave. The suspect, who was identified as Gerald Knott, immediately exited the passenger seat of the vehicle and walked towards me. I gave him numerous verbal commands to face away from me and he was detained and placed into handcuffs. Knott stated that he was just going home to get his Identification card to provide to Home Depot loss prevention because he did not have it on his persons. Knott did admit to attempting to steal a drill bit from the store.

Knott was then placed into Sgt. Casterioto's patrol vehicle and I returned to Home Depot to speak with Miller. Miller stated that he stopped Knott for attempting to leave the store without paying for a Speedmon Spade bit. He stated that it was valued at \$8 and that he simply wanted Knott to identify himself just to have him trespass. Miller stated

that Knott did not have his identification card on him and that he needed to call police to confirm his identity. At that time, Knott fled the store in the above vehicle. Casterioto over the radio that the store did not wish to pursue complaints at this time and that Knott was to be trespassed. Sgt. Casterioto advised Knott that he was trespassed from the store and Knott was released from the scene without further incident. There is no further information to report at this time. The case is closed pending any future complaints.

The following is a report of the incident to the best of my recollection. Refer to body worn camera footage for further details.

On June 4, 2024 I was dispatched to Shoprite (200 NJ-73, West Berlin, NJ 08091) for a report of a shoplifting. Upon arrival, I met with Shoprite loss prevention associate Stephen Chambers. Chambers advised me that a male had taken numerous items totaling \$215 and left the store without paying for them. Chambers stated he observed the male get into a minivan and was able to obtain a New Jersey Registration of Chambers showed me security camera footage of the male walking past all points of sale and exiting the store, where he entered a tan Dodge Grand Caravan.

Chambers was provided a link for Axon Evidence, where he submitted the security camera footage of the suspect. On security camera footage, the male was seen entering the store at approximately 2:11 P.M. with two females and a younger male. The suspect was a black male wearing a black t-shirt, tan shorts, and black slides. The male and the adult female walked around the store and selected numerous items and placed them into the shopping cart. Once they were finished, the adult female along with the other female went to the register and paid for a separate cart full of items. The suspect male then walked past all points of sale at 2:56 P.M. without making any attempt to pay for the items in the cart. Screen shot photographs of the suspects were entered into RMS.

I checked RMS to see if the suspect's vehicle had any documented cases. The vehicle had been stopped in Voorhees Township in May of 2024 with a Jasmine Santana as the driver. I made several attempts to contact Santana via phone. When she finally answered, she stated that she didn't know which incident I was referring to. I checked Santana's profile on RMS and there were numerous photographs of her in the images tab. I confirmed through those photographs that Santana was the adult female involved in the shoplifting. Santana had a chest tattoo documented in RMS that matched that of the female from this incident. Santana was charged on 06/19/2024 with Shoplifting (2C:20-11B(1)) and Conspiracy (2C:5-2A(1)) under summons #0406 S 2024 000[REDACTED].
