On the above date and approximate time I Ofc. Singleton #1263, was on patrol in the area of Putnam and Copper Street where I observed a vehicle moving in an aggressive high rate of speed approaching my marked patrol vehicle. I turned right onto Cooper. The suspect vehicle behind me followed. I then began to pull over to the right side of the road. The vehicle attempted to go around me crossing the solid yellow double lines. As the vehicle passed I observed the vehicle to have unclear plates and a light not illuminating over the license plate. I conducted a motor vehicle stop on Cooper and Hess Street. (Vehicle was later identified baring a NJ registration B94VBL, 2013 Chevrolet sedan registered to the defendant Stevie Dailey).

When I approached the vehicle, I observed all four windows down having a heavy odor of a raw marijuana smell and alcoholic beverage imitating from the interior of the vehicle. I had an interaction with this male approximately 30 minutes prior to this traffic stop. During this interaction, Dailey had and open container of an alcoholic beverage with several males. Dailey had a slurred speech, looked disheveled, and fell to the ground in front of 205 Laurel Street. I advised the males not to drive and to keep the noise down. One of the males stated that he lived at the 205 Laurel Street residence.

Dailey was asked to step out of the vehicle after I retrieved his documents. Stevie Dailey was pat searched for weapons for my safety and his. Additional units were then requested to my location for field sobriety test. Ofc. Lusener #1110, Sgt. Maloney #1102, Ofc. Lackraj #1430, Sgt. Dunn #1418 responded to my location. Ofc. Lackraj #1430, Sgt. Dunn #1418 performed field sobriety testing. Dailey failed walk and turn test, one leg stand test, and the horizontal gaze nystagmus test, and was placed under arrest at approximately 0120 hours. See Ofc. Lackraj #1430 and Sgt. Dunn #1418 supplemental report for further.

Dailey was place into rear passenger compartment of my patrol unit and central communications was notified. A tow truck was dispatched to my location.

On November 9, 2024, Ptl. Singleton of the Beverly City Police Department requested backup units to assist him on his traffic stop. I arrived on location along with other officers to provide assistance to Ptl. Singleton. Ptl. Singleton advised me that the operator of the vehicle (Stevie Dailey) was possibly under the influence of alcohol or drugs and asked me to perform field sobriety tests to determine impairment.

I asked Mr. Dailey to stand in front of me and place his right foot in front of his left foot, touching his right heel to his left toe. When instructing Mr. Dailey on how to stand he kept repeating if he can put his hands down to his sides. Mr. Dailey was visually upset and crying. Mr. Dailey would ask if it was ok to put his hands down, then raise his hands back up and repeat the question over again. Mr. Dailey was continuously asking to call his mother or have another officer contact his mother. Myself, and other officers on scene informed Mr. Dailey that contacting his mother was not possible at the moment as we had some tests to complete. I asked Mr. Dailey if he was willing to continue with the field tests and he stated yes. I also advised Mr. Dailey that if he asked for an officer to contact his mother prior to completing the field tests, I would terminate the tests and treat it as if he was refusing to complete the SFST's.

Walk and Turn Test:

I again advised Mr. Dailey to place his right foot in front of his left foot, keeping his arms to his sides and to maintain that position while I explained and demonstrated the test to him. I advised Mr. Dailey to take nine steps forward, walking heel to toe, keeping his arms at his side and to count his steps out loud. I advised him after he reached the ninth step, to pivot (turn) and take nine steps in the direction that he started also walking heel to toe. Mr. Dailey stated that he understood the test and began. Mr. Dailey walked the nine steps stepping off line once, completed the turn and walked nine steps back. While walking back, Mr. Dailey stepped off line once more and finished the test competing the required nine steps. **Score: 2**

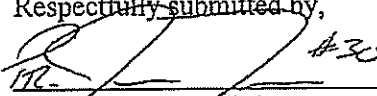
One Leg Stand Test:

I asked the Dailey if he had any injuries that would prevent him from standing on one foot, and he stated "No". Mr. Dailey was standing on level sidewalk, next to his vehicle on Cooper Street. I advised the Mr. Dailey that I did not want him to do anything until I was finished explaining and demonstrating the test to him. After explaining and demonstrating the test, I asked Mr. Dailey if he understood the instructions, and he stated "Yes". Mr. Dailey began the test and picked up his right foot off the ground. Mr. Dailey counted the required numbers, however, did not pick his foot six inches off the ground. Mr. Dailey was awarded another chance to complete this this test. I explained the instructions one more time and asked Mr. Dailey to

begin. Prior to beginning the test, Mr. Dailey asked if an officer was able to contact his mother due to him being scared. I informed Mr. Dailey that the test was now terminated and he was placed under arrest. I placed Mr. Dailey's arms behind his back and cuffed him to the rear. As I was adjusting and double locking the cuffs, I could detect and odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Mr. Dailey. Mr. Dailey was then turned over to Ptl. Singleton.

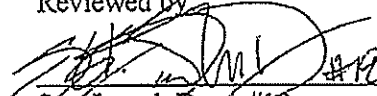
No field notes exist for this report and BWC #18 & #30 were activated and recording during the entire incident.

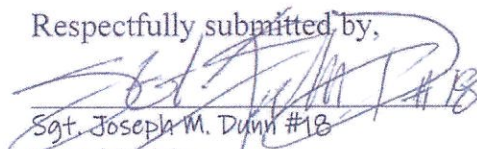

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test:

I asked the driver if he could see my finger in front of his face and he stated that he could. I placed my right index finger approximately twelve inches in front of the driver's face and instructed him as to what I wanted him to do. I observed that both pupils were equal in size and shape and I could see them slightly reacting to the surrounding lights. I did not observe a resting Nystagmus. His eyes were glassy and bloodshot around the edges. I tracked the driver's right and left eyes; they were both equally tracking and a Nystagmus was observed. I checked the driver's right and left eye for smooth pursuit and observed a Nystagmus. I checked the driver's right and left eye at maximum deviation and observed a Nystagmus. I checked the driver's right and left eye at onset before forty-five degrees and observed a Nystagmus. While I was standing in front of the driver, I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth while he was breathing. **Total Score: 6.**
