The County of Salem received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on May 24, 2023. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is June 5, 2023. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 1st business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"Please send the final and compiled bid tabulation (Bid Tally), including all quantities and unit pricing for each bidder, for Resurfacing & Safety Improv of Willow Grove Road, County Road #639 that was submitted on 7/7/20."

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request:
Final Bid Tabulation for Resurfacing & Safety Improvements of Willow Grove Road, County Road #639 that was submitted on 7/7/20.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Salem to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
