Bidder acknowledges that estimated quantities are not guaranteed, and are solely for the purpose of comparison of Bids, and final payment for Unit Price Bid items will be based on actual quantities, determined as provided in the Contract Documents.

The bidder shall complete Schedule of Quantities for the Bid. Failure to furnish a completed Schedule of Quantities for the Bid within the bid proposal shall be cause for the rejection of the bid.

The Borough shall base the Basis of award for this project(s) on the lowest responsible bidder (one bidder only). The low bid will be subject to Borough Committee's decision for the lowest total bid amount based upon the Bid amount items based on availability of funds. The Borough of Glassboro shall award the contract **in the best interest of the Borough of Glassboro** to the lowest most responsible and responsive bidder.

SPECIAL NOTES

- A. The contractor is advised to immediately inform the Borough in the event that the field conditions and measurements do not match those in the specification. The Contractor is not to proceed with any additional work without written authorization from the Borough.
- B. Curb ramps and Sidewalks that are constructed not in compliance with ADA accessibility requirements including maximum running slopes, maximum cross slopes, landing area location and size, diverging sidewalk drop off protection, blended transitions, blended transition running slopes and cross slopes, flare widths, grade breaks and grade break directions, clear space size and location, will not be accepted.
- C. All existing signs, inlet curb pieces and grates shall be returned to the Borough as soon as they are removed. It is the Contractor's responsibility to deliver them to the Public Works yard.
- D. The Contractor must provide compaction & air void reports for the surface course.
- E. Relocation of any mail box will fall under CLEARING SITE. The Contractor must reference the N.J.D.O.T. Specifications, if applicable.
- F. The Contractor shall provide a Traffic Control Coordinator to supervise the requirements for traffic control as identified in Section 6 of the MUTCD and the typical traffic control plan. All traffic control measures must be in compliance with MUTCD.
- G. The Contractor shall be responsible for notifying Gloucester County Soil Conservation District the start of the project and adhere to all the requirements set for on the approved permit. Final approval from Gloucester County Soil Conservation District will be required as part of the final close out of this project.
- H. Reference Division 150, Contract Requirements, Section 151, Performance Bond & Payment Bond for bond requirements within the Special Provisions.
- I. Concrete and Asphalt must be from an approved NJDOT plant. Link provided below:

- (1) To notify the Public Agency Compliance Officer, the Division, and minority and women referral organizations listed by the Division pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.3, of its workforce needs, and request referral of minority and women workers;
- (2) To notify any minority and women workers who have been listed with it as awaiting available vacancies;
- (3) Prior to commencement of work, to request that the local construction trade union refer minority and women workers to fill job openings, provided the contractor or subcontractor has a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for the construction trade;
- (4) To leave standing requests for additional referral to minority and women workers with the local construction trade union, provided the contractor or subcontractor has a referral agreement or arrangement with a union for the construction trade, the State Training and Employment Service and other approved referral sources in the area until such time as the workforce is consistent with the employment goal;
- (5) If it is necessary to lay off some of the workers in a given trade on the construction site, to assure, consistent with the applicable State and Federal statutes and court decisions, that sufficient minority and women employees remain on the site consistent with the employment goal; and to employ any minority and women workers laid off by the contractor on any other construction site on which its workforce composition is not consistent with an employment goal established pursuant to rules implementing N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq.;
- (6) To adhere to the following procedure when minority and women workers apply or are referred to the contractor or subcontractor:
 - (i) If said individuals have never previously received any document or certification signifying a level of qualification lower than that required in order to perform the work of the construction trade, the contractor or subcontractor shall determine the qualifications of such individuals and if the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce in each construction trade is not consistent with the applicable employment goal, it shall hire or schedule those individuals who satisfy appropriate qualification standards. However, a contractor or subcontractor shall determine that the individual at least possesses the requisite skills, and experience recognized by a union, apprentice program or a referral agency, provided the referral agency is acceptable to the Division. If necessary, the contractor or subcontractor shall hire or schedule minority and

women workers who qualify as trainees pursuant to these rules. All of the requirements, however, are limited by the provisions of (C) below.

- (ii) If the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce is consistent with the applicable employment goal, the name of any interested women or minority individual shall be maintained on a waiting list for the first consideration, in the event the contractor's or subcontractor's workforce is no longer consistent with the applicable employment goal.
 - (iii) If, for any reason, said contractor or subcontractor determines that a minority individual or a women is not qualified or if the individual qualifies as an advanced trainee or apprentice, the contractor or subcontractor shall inform the individual in writing of the reasons for the determination, maintain a copy of the determination in its files, and send a copy to the public agency compliance officer and to the Division.
