RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 363

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTVILLE, COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS FUEL PUMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to authorization by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Montville, the Township received sealed competitive bids for the Public Works Fuel Pump Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, four (4) sealed bids were received and opened on November 10, 2022, in accordance with the advertised date for acceptance of bids, from the following vendors:

(1)	Aurora Environmental, LLC	\$749,360.00
(2)	TR Weniger, Inc.	\$774,810.00
(3)	Betts Environmental Services, Corp.	\$893,868.31
(4)	T. Slack Environmental Services	\$983,160.00

; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Aurora Environmental, LLC, which was determined to be the lowest bid, exceeds the funds allocated for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee find and declare that all bids received exceed the Engineer's estimate and the funds allocated for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, specifically N.J.S.A. §40A:11-13.2 authorizes a municipality to reject all bids; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee find and declare that in light of the withdrawal by the lowest bidder and the remaining bids being over budget, there are no responsible bidders and all bids are rejected; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee authorize the Public Works Fuel Pump Replacement Project to be re-bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of the Township of Montville, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey that all bids received for the Public Works Fuel Pump Replacement Project be and are hereby rejected for the reasons stated in this Resolution.

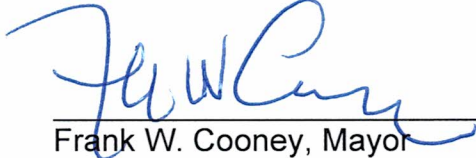
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Administration is authorized to re-bid the Public Works Fuel Pump Replacement Project.
