**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING READVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR KIWANIS
COMMUNITY PARK ADA COMPLIANCE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 287-12-2022, City Council authorized the readvertisement for Bids for the Kiwanis Community Park ADA Compliance Project; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2023, the City conducted a bid opening and received five bids;
and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 61-01-2023, City Council directed an application to the Cape May County Open Space Program to fund the Kiwanis Community Park project. The City intends to proceed with this project pending the County's response to its funding request; and

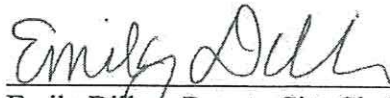
WHEREAS, due to the withdrawal of bids received and anticipating further feedback from the County Open Space program, the City of Cape May intends to proceed with its County application for funding and then readvertise for the receipt of bids for the Kiwanis Community Park ADA Compliance Project; and

WHEREAS, the Cape May City Council has determined it to be in the best interests of the City to readvertise for bids for the Kiwanis Community Park ADA Compliance project as described herein, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Cape May, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Recital paragraphs are incorporated as if fully set forth.
2. The Cape May City Council hereby reauthorizes the advertisement for bids in connection with Kiwanis Community Park ADA Compliance project in the City of Cape May, pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law. All bids received pursuant to the January 11, 2023 opening are hereby rejected.
3. The appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to execute take all steps necessary to readvertise for bids for this project.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage, according to law.
