

PROPOSAL

The undersigned hereby declares that the site of the work and the contract documents have been examined and that the work will be carried out and completed, if this proposal is accepted, as specified. The undersigned will provide all superintendence, labor, material, tools and equipment, and all else necessary therefore and incidental thereto, for the items in the proposal, complete in place, at the price per unit of measure for each scheduled item of work stated in the following schedule of values. Accompanying this proposal is a "Consent of Surety" guaranteeing that, in the event the contract is awarded to the undersigned, both performance and payment bonds will be provided as specified. Also accompanying this proposal is a bid bond, cashier's check or certified check in the amount of 10% of the bid amount, not to exceed \$20,000, payable to the owner, which will be forfeited as liquidated damages should the contract be awarded to the undersigned and the undersigned fail to execute said contract within 10 days of written notice by the owner.

All blank spaces on the proposal forms shall be filled out with ink or typewritten. Any erasures or other changes shall be signed or initialed by the authorized bidder. Any omissions from these forms shall be cause for rejection of the bid.

The bid shall include all items outlined on the bid document submission checklist, including the checklist itself.

In the event of a discrepancy in the Schedule of Values, the unit price written in words shall supersede the unit price written in figures, the unit prices shall supersede the extended totals, and the extended totals shall supersede the summation by the bidder.

When purchasing the bid documents, all bidders must fill out the bidders list form. Bids will not be accepted from bidders on the State's debarred list. Any addenda to this bid package will be sent by certified mail to the address provided on the bidders list, no later than 7 working days prior to the bid opening.

The owner reserves the right to hold a hearing to determine whether any particular bidder is qualified to do the proposed work. Any ties between bidders will be resolved by an equitable means of randomly choosing the apparent low bidder, to be determined by the engineer. Payroll certifications will be reviewed and approved by the owner's Chief Financial Officer.

Contractors are advised that all work must be completed no later than 7/1/22. The contractor shall be liable for liquidated damages, in the agreed upon amount of \$850.00/day if the contract is not substantially completed within the time period specified herein.
