Dear Requestor,

The Borough of Woodbine received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on May 19, 2023. The official Records Custodian, Alexander Bauer, received your OPRA request on May 22, 2023. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is May 31, 2023. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 3rd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Attached are the responsive records to your request for final and compiled bid tabulation (Bid Tally), including all quantities and unit pricing for each bidder, for Taxiway B Rehabilitation Phase 1 that was submitted on 6/12/20.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Woodbine to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
