The Borough of Woodbine received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on January 25, 2023. The official Records Custodian, Alexander Bauer, received your OPRA request on January 26, 2023. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is February 8, 2023. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 4th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your request is granted: Please send the final and compiled bid tabulation, including all quantities and unit pricing for each bidder, for "Bikeway at Eco-Park" that was submitted on 5/19/2020.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Woodbine to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
