- All invoices submitted by the law firm of Triarsi, Betancourt, Wukovits and Dugan for billing purposes to the Township of Clark from 4/15/20 to date, for all services rendered to the Township of Clark, its officials, employees and others in reference to Antonio Manata or his attorney; and
- All of the Township's Purchases Orders in reference to the above mentioned billing records.

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request:

- Township of Clark Invoices (redacted) – 57 pages. The redactions represent billings for services that do not pertain to the OPRA request.

The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
