On November 19, 2024 at 2136 hours, Patrolman Peirsel called out to dispatch that he had two (2) vehicles stopped in the Quick Check parking lot (132 Hamburg Turnpike). At this time, he requested me to the scene for assistance. Shortly after, I arrived on scene and observed a male, later identified as Jeffrey Fogarty to be yelling and becoming aggressive with Patrolman Peirsel. I exited my vehicle and ran over to assist. Patrolman Peirsel advised that Mr. Fogarty was under arrest and demanded he put his hands on the front of his patrol vehicle. He was ordered to do so multiple times at which time Mr. Fogarty refused to comply. He slammed his hands on the front of the vehicle and then became more aggressive towards Patrolman Peirsel. As I saw how aggressive Mr. Fogarty was becoming, I requested Butler PD send additional units for officer safety.

Patrolman Peirsel began walking towards Mr. Fogarty to place him in handcuffs to which Mr. Fogarty yelled "you're not arresting me homie" and quickly backed away.

Patrolman Peirsel then advised that he was under arrest and ordered him back to the patrol vehicle. He then took a fighting stance towards Patrolman Peirsel and continued backing up. At this time, Patrolman Peirsel deployed his OC Spray, which was unsuccessful. Mr. Fogarty was sprayed again by Patrolman Peirsel and which time he began to walk away from us and eventually began to run Eastbound on Hamburg Turnpike.

I began to run after him at which time Patrolman Peirsel advised me not to chase him. I then stopped at which time Mr. Fogarty stopped as well turned around and took another fighting stance and began walking towards my direction yelling "what the fuck is your problem?!" At this time I deployed my OC Spray at Mr. Fogarty. Patrolman Peirsel ran over and sprayed him as well and ordered Mr. Fogarty to lay down on the ground. He was ordered to do so multiple times before finally complying. He was then handcuffed by Patrolman Peirsel and was assisted to his feet. I assisted in bringing Mr. Fogarty over to Patrolman Peirsel's patrol vehicle. While we maintained control of him, Mr. Fogarty began reaching into his right pocket. He was ordered to keep his hands out of his pockets. He was searched by Patrolman Peirsel which he found a switch blade that was seized for safe keeping, a bandana that had a padlock tied to the end of it as well as other miscellaneous items.

Mr. Fogarty was placed inside the patrol vehicle at which time he could be heard screaming and banging the inside of the vehicle.

Patrolman Peirsel requested I issue Mr. Fogarty's girlfriend, Natalie Jejenich on his behalf as she was the initial vehicle he had stopped. Patrolman Peirsel transported Mr. Fogarty to Police Headquarters with assistance of Butler PD Units that were now on scene.
