Narrative:

On January 8th, 2025, at approximately 2155 hours, patrol responded to the Turnpike Discount Liquors located at 139 Hamburg Turnpike on a report of shoplifting. Upon arrival, patrol met with the clerk, Alkesh Patel.

Alkesh indicated that a tall, white male, wearing a light colored jacket and winter hat had taken two (2) bottles of liquor and ran out of the store without paying for the items. Alkesh made his way to the door and observed a light colored sedan exiting the parking lot at a high rate of speed, turning right out of the parking lot and continuing east onto Hamburg Turnpike.

Alkesh indicated that he has never seen the male prior to this evening. He also advised that the male entered the store via side door and walked around before taking the two (2) bottles. The male reportedly made a comment to Alkesh similar to "all of the liquor stores are closed around here".

Note: Alkesh indicated that the incident had taken place just prior to contacting police at approximately 2150 hours.

The two (2) bottles stolen are as follows: (both prices are listed before NJ sales tax).

Corralejo Tequila - \$49.99

Gordon's London Dry Gin - \$39.99

A total loss of \$89.98 USD.

Alkesh provided pedigree information for his boss, Bhoomika "Bhoomi" Patel. Bhoomi was contacted by Alkesh and requested to access the store's surveillance system. She was instructed to forward any photo / video of the incident to my departmental e-mail.

At approximately 2235 hours, I received an e-mail from Bhoomi with photographs and videos of the shoplifting taking place.

The first video depicts the following:

At 21:48:15 hours, a silver Honda Odyssey mini van is observed parking in the rear of the Turnpike Discount Liquors. The driver door opens and a white male exits same. The driver door was left open as the male suspect exited the vehicle and ran into the store.

The male then enters the side door of the establishment. At 21:48:33 hours, the male is observed exiting the store via side door and runs into the driver seat of the suspect vehicle. He then exits heads north in the parking lot towards the exit at a high rate of speed. The suspect vehicle then exits the cameras point of view.

A second video depicts the following:

At 21:48:22, the male is observed entering the store via side door. The suspect, observed to be a tall, white male wearing a green hooded jacket, blue jeans, a green wool bomber style hat, and beige/sand colored boots (believed to be Timberland boots) enters the store. His jacket appeared to have a black colored patch on the right arm.

At 21:48:29, the male is observed to turn right to the nearest shelf and takes the two (2) bottles of alcohol. He then exits the store at 21:48:33 hours.

Also attached in the e-mail are two (2) photographs of the male from earlier in the evening. The images are clear and were attached to the digital media of this case file. The videos were also attached to the digital media of this case file.

At approximately 22:58 hours, Bhoomi forwarded two (2) more videos to my departmental e-mail. The two videos depict the vehicle entering the parking lot the first time the male entered the store at 21:43:15 hours.

21:46:53 hours, the suspect male exits the side door and returns to his vehicle. The vehicle backs and makes a full 90 degree turn while backing. The front of the vehicle is now observed in which two (2) windshield stickers are observed near the bottom right side of the windshield. The stickers are believed to be a State of New York registration and inspection. The vehicle is also observed to bear a possible New York license plate as the plate appears dark yellow with a dark blue stripe across its top.

The vehicle then makes a left turn and continues near the rear of the store. There, a large white colored cover is observed to cover the rear passenger side window and appears to be taped to same.

Note: The suspect Honda Odyssey is believed to be between the production years of 2008-2010 as per Google search. A photograph obtained via Google search was attached to the digital media of this case as a reference as the vehicle rims match between the timeframe of 2008-2010.

Quick Chek cameras were viewed in hopes of retrieving more footage of the suspect/ suspect vehicle, however nothing of evidential value was observed. DB notified via power dms.

An O.P.S. L.E.N.S. flyer was created in attempt to identify the male suspect.

On the above mentioned date, during the morning hours, I was notified by Bloomington Sergeant (Sgt.) Zeidan that a theft occurred on January 8th, 2025 at approximately 2148 hours. The theft took place at 139 Hamburg Turnpike (Turnpike Discount Liquors). After reviewing the initial Investigation Report (IR), authored by Patrolman (Ptl.) Moore, as well as the video surveillance footage gathered, the following was observed:

The suspect was operating a silver colored Honda Odyssey mini van which appears to be bearing a State of New York registration as it appears to be dark yellow in color with blue. The vehicle was also observed to have two (2) windshield stickers applied to the bottom driver side of the windshield.

The suspect observed in the surveillance footage is a tall white male, thinner build, wearing a green colored hooded jacket (black and gray patch on upper right sleeve), blue colored jeans, green colored bomber style winter hat, and beige colored work boots.

The suspect is then seen fleeing the scene, after stealing two (2) bottles of liquor, at 21:48:33 hours. The suspect vehicle is observed traveling north within the parking lot, toward Hamburg Turnpike, at a high rate of speed. It is believed the suspect vehicle then traveled eastbound on Hamburg Turnpike toward Main Street.

Given the above mentioned information, Det. Calabro and myself went to 2 Riverside Square (7-Eleven) to review their video surveillance footage in hopes of identifying the suspect vehicle as it travels on Main Street. Upon further review the following was observed:

On January 8th, 2025, at 21:50:29 hours, the suspect vehicle is clearly observed pulling into the parking lot of the 7-Eleven and parks his vehicle, bearing New York registration JGJ1566. The suspect vehicle parks head on in the third parking space near the front of the store. The suspect is then seen exiting the drivers seat of the vehicle and enters the store. **It should be noted that the suspect is positively identified as the same actor who committed the shoplifting at Turnpike Discount Liquors. The male is operating the same vehicle as well as wearing the same exact clothing. While within the store the suspect is observed, at 21:51:40 hours, removing two (2) hot dogs from the counter with his left hand. The suspect then switches them to his right hand, behind his back so the store employee would not see. The suspect then walks out of the store without paying for same. The suspect then gets back into his vehicle and pulls into the eastbound lane of Main Street, leaving the scene.**

A check via eAgent for NY registration JGJ1566 revealed the registered owner to be Anton Naumkin, who resides at 545 Kensico Ct., Suffern, NY 10901. A mug shot inquiry via eAgent provided this officer with several clear photos of Naumkin which were able to be positively identified as the actor shown in the surveillance footage.

Complaint summons was then sent to Suffern Police Department's Sgt. Yorke at 12:20 PM to be served to Naumkin. Sgt. Yorke advised that he will contact this officer to confirm when Naumkin is served.

Sgt. Yorke advised this officer that service of the complaint summons was completed at 1320 hours on January 9th, 2025 by Suffern PD Officer Dan Wynne.
