RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOMS RIVER REGIONAL SCHOOLS TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DOVER MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

Whereas, NJSA 18A:18A-11 authorizes joint agreements to assist municipalities and governmental agencies for the purchasing of supplies, materials, or work with the governing body of the municipality or county within whose boundaries any such district is wholly or partly located, and

Whereas, the Toms River Regional Schools Board of Education wishes to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Dover Municipal Utilities Authority for assistance in purchasing gasoline and/or diesel fuel for the period covering July 1, 1998, through June 30, 1999,

Whereas, the Toms River Regional Schools Board of Education is fully insured by Coregis Insurance for liability coverage should an incident or accident occur,

Now therefore be it Resolved, that the total amount of purchases as covered under this agreement shall not exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), during the term of this contract,

Now therefore be it further Resolved, pursuant to the provision of NJSA 18A:19-2, the Board Secretary, Jerald A. Jellerts, is hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Dover Municipal Utilities Authority.
