

NOTICE OF SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 10, 1968

NOTICE IS HEREBY given to the legal voters of the School District of the Township of Brick, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey, that a Special Election of the legal voters of said District will be held on Tuesday, the 10th day of December, 1968, at 2:00 o'clock p.m.

The polls will remain open until 9:00 o'clock p.m., and as much longer as may be necessary to permit all the legal voters then present to vote and to cast their ballots. The election will be held and all the legal voters of the School District will vote at the respective polling places stated below.

At the said election, the following will be submitted:

PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Township of Brick in the County of Ocean is authorized (a) to acquire as a site for new schoolhouses the plots of land in the School District described as follows:

Lots 15, 16, 17 and 18 on Block 1068 as indicated on the Tax Map of the Township of Brick at Page 57; and Lot 4 on Block 1107 as indicated on the Tax Map of the Township of Brick on Page 58,

and to expend therefor, including incidental expenses, not exceeding \$85,000; (b) to construct on said plots of land a new elementary schoolhouse and a new middle schoolhouse and to improve said plots of land; to construct at the site of the present High School on Chambers Bridge Road an additional high school building and to improve said site and to purchase the school furniture and other equipment and apparatus required for said schools and to expend therefor not exceeding \$5,160,000; and (c) to issue bonds of the school district for said purposes in the principal amount of \$5,245,000, thus using up \$3,564,419.72 of the \$6,502,271.55 borrowing margin of the Township of Brick previously available for other improvements.

The polling places for said election and their respective polling districts (described by reference to the election) are established and have been designated as follows and no person shall vote at said election elsewhere than at the polling place designated for the voters of the polling district in which he or she resides.

POLLING DISTRICT NO. 1

Polling place at the Drum Point Road School at 41 Drum Point Road in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Election District Nos. 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11.

POLLING DISTRICT NO. 2

Polling place at the Laurelton School on Route 88, 1819 Ocean Avenue, in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Election District Nos. 3, 4 and 14.

POLLING DISTRICT NO. 3

Polling place at the Lanes Mill School at 1891 Lanes Mill Road in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Election District Nos. 1 and 2.

POLLING DISTRICT NO. 4

Polling place at the High School on Chambers Bridge Road in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Election District Nos. 6, 13 and 16.

POLLING DISTRICT NO. 5

Polling place at the Midstreams School at 500 Midstreams Road, in the School District, for legal voters residing within General Election District Nos. 5, 12 and 15.

PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Township of Brick in the County of Ocean is authorized (a) to acquire as a site for new schoolhouses the plots of land in the School District described as follows: Lots 15, 16, 17 and 18 on Block 1068 as indicated on the Tax Map of the Township of Brick at Page 57; and Lot 4 on Block 1107 as indicated on the Tax Map of the Township of Brick on Page 58,

and to expend therefor, including incidental expenses, not exceeding \$85,000; (b) to construct on said plots of land a new elementary schoolhouse and a new middle schoolhouse and to improve said plots of land; to construct at the site of the present High School on Chambers Bridge Road an additional high school building and to improve said site and to purchase the school furniture and other equipment and apparatus required for said schools and to expend therefor not exceeding \$5,160,000; and (c) to issue bonds of the school district for said purposes in the principal amount of \$5,245,000, thus using up \$3,564,419.72 of the \$6,502,271.55 borrowing margin of the Township of Brick previously available for other improvements.
