NOTICE TO PERSONS DESIRING ABSENTEE BALLOTS

If you are a qualified and registered voter of the State of New Jersey who expects to be absent outside the State on February 13, 1968, or a qualified and registered voter who will be within the State on February 13, 1968, but because of illness or physical disability, or because of the observance of a religious holiday pursuant to the tenets of your religion, or because of resident attendance at a school, college or university, will be unable to cast your ballot at the polling place in your district on said date, and you desire to vote in the annual school election to be held on February 13, 1968, kindly write or apply in person to the undersigned at once requesting that a civilian absentee ballot be forwarded to you.

Such request must state your home address, and the address to which said ballot should be sent, and must be signed with your signature and state the reason why you will not be able to vote at your usual polling place. No civilian absentee ballot will be furnished or forwarded to any applicant unless request therefore is received not less than 3 days prior to the election, and contains the foregoing information.
