

Dr. Aragona distributed memorandums to the board members showing a recommended list of items Administration was recommending be restored to the 1983-84 submitted budget. He also recommended that in addition to the \$1,270,782. listed on the one page, that an additional \$40,000. be restored in the account that will cover litigation and additional estimated attorneys' fees. Mr. Bell recommended that the Board accept Administration's recommendations and add this \$1,310,782. to the tentative school budget statement to be submitted to the Ocean County Superintendent of Schools.

Dr. Aragona began the discussion of the 100 Accounts by taking individual sections and making explanations of deletions, additions, etc. It was in the 120d account that Dr. Aragona noted the \$40,000. would be increased for possible litigation expenses.

As he continued with the 200 accounts he explained where his restoration recommendations fitted in, and the effect of the increases in said accounts, including the restoration of \$100,000. in the 240 Account for general supplies.

After reviewing the 300 and 400 accounts, Dr. Aragona continued on to the 1000, 1100 and 1200 accounts and made special references to areas within these sections where his recommended restorations had effect. Monies restored at this time in the 1100 sections would, if recommendation holds through further discussions and hearings, would allow this board to have summer school, a work study program, and Camp Beadleston.

Reference was made to the need to set monies aside to purchase replacement equipment for Brick Township High School, possibly piece by piece, by age of said equipment. This money, if the board so chooses to assign funds for this purpose, would be added to the 730A account for replacement of equipment. Mr. Wolfersberger and Mr. Robert Messemer are to be consulted for their opinions on needs.

By consensus vote, there was unanimous agreement that the amounts totaling \$1,310,782., be restored to the budget to be presented to the Ocean County Superintendent of Schools. Notation was made that the Board has the prerogative of adding or deleting any amounts up to and including the date of the Public Hearing, that this approval was in order that the Business Administrator can submit his report to the Ocean County Superintendent as mandated.

A budget meeting was set for Tuesday, January 18th at 7:30 p.m., and it was noted that there is a meeting scheduled with members of the B.T.E.A. for January 20th. Mr. Bell also noted that he has to set a meeting with the Board of Fire Commissioners, and would do so shortly.

At 9:15 p.m. motion was made by Mr. Tremper, seconded by Mr. Williams and carried unanimously to adjourn this meeting.
