

January 11, 1984
Brick, New Jersey

The Brick Township Board of Education held their Regular Public Meeting on Wednesday, January 11, 1984 at 7:55 p.m. in the Administration Building, 101 Hendrickson Avenue.

Present were: Mr. Roblenski, Mr. Bittmann (8:10 p.m.), Mrs. Benton, Mr. Tremper and Mr. Williams.

Also present: Mr. Wolf, Mr. Stutts and Mr. Anton.

Mr. Stutts announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time, and place thereof posted on January 5, 1984 as follows: Board Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, Municipal Clerk, and Brick Town News.

Mr. Roblenski announced at this time the Board's intention of presenting a plaque to Mr. Anthony Donofrio, a previous board member, for his dedicated and unselfish service to the youth and Brick Township community, during the three years he served from 1980 to 1983. Mr. Williams presented the plaque to Mr. Donofrio and expressed the board's appreciation for his service and participation while a board member.

Representative students from both high schools were present and Mr. Roblenski asked the board members if they were agreeable to allowing these students to make their presentation before the agenda was presented. All members were agreeable to this.

They had come to the meeting to speak of the proposed policy to exempt certain students from examinations if they had attained certain grades. Their original suggestion was that if a student had attained a grade average of 93 they would be exempt from taking exams in those subjects to a total of three classes. The Administration had recommended an average of 95 and a limit of two exempt classes. After a discussion of pros and cons of this item, a motion was made by Mr. Tremper, seconded by Mr. Bittmann and carried unanimously by roll call vote to approve including a motion on this matter this evening.

Motion was made by Mr. Williams, seconded by Mrs. Benton and carried unanimously by roll call vote that the Board of Education approve an average of 94 and a maximum of exemption from taking examinations in two subjects (policy subject to review after this marking period and tabulation of how many students are affected).

Other students who have attained honors in Soccer were introduced, and note was made of the fact that our student Kim Majury had been selected to be on the State Student Council Executive Committee.

At 8:40 p.m. presentation of the agenda was begun.

Minutes Motion was made by Mrs. Benton, seconded by Mr. Tremper and agreed to unanimously by roll call vote to approve Minutes submitted for a Pre-Agenda Meeting, December 6, 1983; Regular Public Meeting, December 8, 1983; and Special Meeting, December 15, 1983.

Curr. & Inst. Motion was made by Mrs. Benton, seconded by Mr. Tremper and carried unanimously by roll call vote to approve items under Curriculum and Instruction.

Special Ed. Program Motion to approve the Annual Special Education Program for the 1984-85 school year, for all Handicapped Children.

Motion to approve the 1984-87 Plan for the Education of all Handicapped Children.

Motion to approve the application for the ECIA, Chapter I, FY 1983 Carry-over Funds in the amount of \$28,813.00.

Finance and Business Motion was made by Mrs. Benton and seconded by Mr. Bittmann to approve the items under Finance and Business. A roll call vote was taken with the following results: Mrs. Benton-yes; Mr. Bittmann-yes; Mr. Tremper-yes; Mr. Williams-no; and Mr. Roblenski-yes.
