The Brick Township Board of Education held their Regular Public Meeting at 7:55 p.m. on Wednesday, January 25, 1989 in the Administration Building, 101 Hendrickson Avenue, Brick, New Jersey.

Present were: Mrs. DeConde, Mr. Cevasco, Mr. Readel, Mr. Stites, Mr. D'Ambola and Mrs. Benton.

Also present: Dr. Aragona, Mr. Wolf, Mr. Stutts and Mr. Sendzik.

SUNSHINE LAW Mr. Stutts announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted on January 20, 1989 as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, Municipal Clerk and Brick Town News.

MR. WILLIAMSON Mr. Readel, presiding over the meeting in Mr. Williamson's absence, read a letter from Mr. Williamson who is recovering from a double bypass operation. Mr. Williamson is doing well and asked Mr. Readel to convey his thanks to all who sent him good wishes.

MR. SHUPIN Mr. Readel then introduced Mr. Anthony Shupin, Director of Public Safety for Brick Township. Mr. Shupin spoke on behalf of the Exchange Club, a group dedicated to community service, who donated \$5,000. for a program to fight drugs. Mr. Readel thanked Mr. Shupin for the donation and also recognized the efforts of Mr. Steve McVey and Mr. Paul Paterson of the Exchange Club.
