RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Education by Decision dated March 15, 1974, has mandated that the action of the Board of Education in not certifying the Charges against Superintendent of Schools, C. Stephen Raciti, was "unreasonable and constitutes an abuse of its discretion;" and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioner has remanded these Charges to the Board of Education mandating that the Board of Education affirmatively certify these said Charges within 45 days or by April 29, 1974.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Township of Brick as follows:

1. Anton and Ward, Attorneys and Solicitors for the Board of Education of the Township of Brick are hereby authorized to file in a timely manner, a copy of the Appeal which is annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

NOTICE OF APPEAL

Respondent-Appellant, the Board of Education of the Township of Brick herewith appeals to the State Board of Education from the Decision of the Commissioner of Education dated March 15, 1974, wherein the Commissioner found and determined that the Respondent-Appellant's decision adoption the Resolution of December 13, 1973, wherein it determined not to certify Petitioner-Appellee's Charges against the Superintendent of Schools, C. Stephen Raciti, to the Commissioner of Education pursuant to

N.J.S.A. 18A:6-11, was unreasonable and constitutes an abuse of its discretion; and,

Wherein the Commissioner further remands these Charges to the Respondent-Appellant and mandated that the Board certify the Charges to the Commissioner of Education within 45 days of the date of the Decision, to wit; March 15, 1974; and,

Asks that said determination be reversed and that Respondent-Appellant not be compelled to Certify said Charges.
