POLICY:

Mr. Montenegro noted that it would benefit all Board Members in terms of voting abstention, the New Jersey Case Law with regard to abstention indicates that if the abstention does not carry with it a reason, either a personal conflict, a financial conflict or relative type of conflict which would be identified by that person or if the person didn't indicate that they were not in favor of the proposal that was before them but yet still abstained, if neither of those factors took place the abstention would be considered with the affirmative and be a yes vote, except when a 2/3 majority is required in which case an abstention is not considered a yes vote.
