Conference

The Brick Township Board of Education held a Conference Meeting on Wednesday, September 13, 1978 at 7:30 p.m. at Veterans Memorial Elementary School for the purpose of discussing additional items for the agenda for the Regular Meeting to follow.

Present were: Mr. Schue, Mrs. Riley, Mrs. Fox, Mr. Bertrand, Mrs. Frake, and Mr. D'Ambola.

Also present: Dr. Aragona, Mr. Wolf, Mr. Stutts and Mr. Anton.

President Schue announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, and Municipal Clerk on September 7, 1978.

Dr. Aragona discussed the revised regulations for Policy No. 456 proposed for adoption this evening. After discussion at length, the members were in agreement to revisions made.

Dr. Aragona also mentioned that an appointment is to be set up with Mr. Strauss with regard to contract for policy revisions. It was suggested that he may be able to come on October 3rd, the night of the Pre-Agenda meeting.

Progress on the new High School building program was presented. State approval came through on Monday, September 9th. Bids will be advertised next week to be received at 3:00 p.m. on October 16th and possibly awarded on the 23rd.

Mr. Bertrand discussed his review of the vouchers. Mr. Schue said he would like to discuss board member expenses at their next meeting.

Other agenda items in pink were discussed by Mr. Stutts.

At 7:55 p.m. Mr. Schue made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Riley and carried unanimously to adjourn this meeting in order to open the Public Meeting.
