SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION
REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS

of the Special School Election of the District of Brick Township, in the County of Ocean, held on December 4, 1976, pursuant to notice given in accordance with School Law. This meeting was held at the Herbertsville, Lanes Mill, Laurelton, Drum Point, Lake Riviera, Osbornville, Veterans Middle, Midstreams and High Schools. The election was opened at 9:00 a.m. by Ruth Henry - Herbertsville School; Emily Sachs - Lanes Mill School; Gladys Christiansen - Laurelton School; Violet Peever - Drum Point School; Frances Fischer - Lake Riviera Middle School; Lois Anderson - Osbornville School; Jean Capoano - Veterans Memorial Middle School; Stella Galik - Midstreams School and Margaret Schmidt - Brick Township High School, who were appointed Judges and designated to open the meeting.

The following election officers were appointed Inspectors: Mary Giles - Herbertsville School; Rita Finan - Lanes Mill School; Gloria Quinn - Laurelton School; Carolyn Hayes - Drum Point School; Irene Cook - Lake Riviera Middle School; Marion Applegate - Osbornville School; Martha Gaspich - Veterans Memorial Middle School; Mary Swiderski - Midstreams School and Helen Ludovico - High School.

There were nine (9) polling places in the school district. The polls were declared open at 9:00 a.m. and closed at 9:00 p.m.

The proposal submitted to the legal voters:

The Board of Education in the Township of Brick, in the County of Ocean, is authorized (a) to acquire by purchase, gift or condemnation as a site for a new schoolhouse the plot of land located in the school district described as follows: Tax Map Pg. 63, Block 1211, Lot 2, approximate acreage 25, and Tax Map Pg. 68, Block 1386, Lot 26, approximate acreage 25, and located on Lanes Mill Road; (b) to construct on said plot of land a new schoolhouse, purchase the school furniture and other equipment necessary therefor and improve the said plot of land; (c) to expend therefor not exceeding \$11,446,000.; and (d) to issue bonds of the school district for said purpose in the amount of \$11,446,000.

Number of names on the poll list was 8,433; Number of ballots counted was 8,428 and Number of ballots voided was 5 and the Number of ballots cast was 8,428.
