The Brick Township Board of Education held a Conference prior to their Regular Public Meeting on Wednesday, December 8, 1976 at 7:30 p.m., in the Veterans Memorial Elementary School, for the purpose of discussing Inter-disciplinary Reading Program at the High School, Thorough and Efficient Education and a personnel matter.

Discuss Inter-disciplinary Reading at H.S.

Mr. Underwood explained a planned Inter-disciplinary Reading Program for the High School at no new cost to the board. It would be financed by a \$5,000. grant. He explained it would be conducted as an in-service or through Montclair evening classes for the high school teachers. The \$5,000. would cover consultant and reading material costs. If possible the program would be expanded to cover the middle schools if money was available. Mr. Kull questioned the board financing this program if the grant was not approved, as he felt the program was very worthwhile in view of the fact that 56% of students have reading deficiencies. (Mr. Underwood left the meeting at 7:50 p.m.)

Discuss T&E

Mr. Raciti discussed T & E that would be approved by the board and Mr. Schue advised the board that T & E would be discussed at a meeting he planned to attend on December 9, 1976 at the County Superintendent's Office.
