The Brick Township Board of Education held a Special Public Meeting on Thursday, June 27, 1985 at 6:02 p.m. in the Administration Building, 101 Hendrickson Avenue for the purpose of discussing and acting upon items listed on an Action Agenda.

Present were: Mrs. Benton, Mr. Roblenski (7:23p.m.), Mrs. DeConde, Mr. Laura, Mr. Readell, Mr. Stites and Mr. Williamson.

Also present: Dr. Aragona (6:10p.m.), Mr. Wolf, Mr. Stutts, Mr. Anton, Mr. Mayer (7:00p.m.) and Mr. Murphy (7:00p.m.).

Mrs. Benton directed that Mr. Stutts read the Sunshine Law as follows: The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time, and place thereof posted on June 24, 1985 as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, Municipal Clerk, and the Brick Town News.

Mr. Stutts read the resolution to go into closed session to discuss a matter involving bid eligibility by a vendor as follows: WHEREAS, C.231, P.L. 1975 also known as the Sunshine Law, authorizes a public body to meet in executive or private session under certain limited circumstances; and

2. That the matter discussed will be made public if and when confidentiality is no longer required and action pursuant to said discussion shall take place only at a public meeting.

Motion was made by Mr. Readell, seconded by Mr. Williamson, and carried unanimously to approve said resolution.

The purpose of this hearing was to give Mr. Ralph Mayo, the Attorney representing Jonah Service Company, the opportunity to clarify allocations to determine whether Jonah Service Company be restored to the vendor list. Mr. Joseph Nifoussi, President of Jonah Service Company, was also present.

Representatives of volunteers from the Brick Township First Aid Squad, Herbertsville First Aid Squad and Herbertsville Fire Company who gave aide at the emergency at Brick Township Memorial High School on June 14, 1985 were presented to the Board. The Board thanked these members for their immediate response in our time of emergency. Mrs. Benton read the following Resolution: (A Resolution for each above service is on file in the Administration Building.)

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on June 14, 1985 there was an unfortunate accident involving a student at the Brick Township Memorial High School; and

WHEREAS, said accident created a serious medical emergency; and

WHEREAS, said emergency was of sufficient magnitude to require the prompt and immediate dispatch of the Herbertsville Fire Company, Herbertsville First Aid Squad, Brick First Aid Squad, Brick Township Police Department, Northern Ocean Hospital Paramedic Unit and the New Jersey State Police; and

WHEREAS, all of the above services required immediate coordination for the benefit and welfare of the student in question; and

WHEREAS, as a result of all of these efforts and as a result of all of the above personnel being able to react in an expeditious manner, the student was able to receive prompt medical attention which hopefully will eliminate or considerably reduce permanent injury; and

WHEREAS, the Brick First Aid Squad assisted in the care, comfort and welfare of said student throughout this unfortunate situation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Brick First Aid Squad and each and every member thereof receive the sincere appreciation and thanks of the Brick Township Board of Education for all of their above said actions which in the context of the situation can truly be described as heroic; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution be published and widely distributed through the community so the public at large is fully aware of the excellent volunteer services available in our Township.
