The Non-Teaching motions were presented by Mr. Stutts. He noted that six motions in this section were upgrades of secretarial personnel through a desk audit done by Civil Service in August, 1985. One of the title changes was questioned by a Board Member, and Mr. Stutts explained this was an upgrade due to the above said desk audit.

Three policies were presented for approval on first reading dealing with the following: Soliciting, Selling and Promoting by Employees; Outside Parties and Gatherings; and Bedside and/or Supplemental Instruction. Another motion presented for approval was the elimination of one section only from the Regulations of a present policy. This section will be removed in order that it not be in conflict with the new policy, Soliciting, Selling and Promoting by Employees.

Auxiliary items were next presented and agreed to.

At this time, Mr. Roblenski apologized to the Board for leaving at his home a Resolution prepared by the Board Attorney regarding the English Language, and requested that it be presented at the Action Agenda Meeting next week. He also asked that all Board

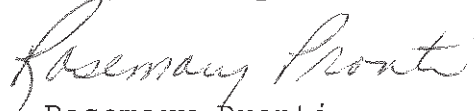
Members be sure to read the Legislative Advisory they recently received. He noted that last year approximately 7000 bills legislating education were proposed; however only 2000 were approved. Of the approved bills some were redundant, some taking choice away from individual school systems and some do not apply to our economic situation.

Mr. Williamson and Mr. Laura reported they are still visiting the various schools in the district and keeping in touch with Mr. Stutts. It was noted that the improvements made in front of Veterans Memorial Elementary School were very nice.
