The Brick Township Board of Education held a conference meeting on Tuesday, September 19, 1978 at 7:30 p.m. in the Board Office, Brick Township High School . Conference

Present were: Mr. Schue, Mrs. Riley, Mr. Bertrand, Mrs. Frake, Mr. D'Ambola, Mrs. Fox and Mr. Hancock.

Also present: Dr. Aragona, Mr. Stutts, Mr. Anton, and Mr. Sendzik. Mr. Wolf.

President Schue announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Sunshine Law Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, and Municipal Clerk on September 14, 1978.

10. Secretarial and clerical transfers.
11. Mr. Anton's letter on Drug Policy.
12. Policy - How to be Developed.
13. Work Study Students to be employed effective September 14, 1978.
14. Correspondence - Connecticut General.

It was recommended that the following committees meet to review Committees items pertaining to their particular committee:

Insurance Committee to review report submitted March 17, 1976 by Insurance Buyers Council.

Buildings and Grounds Committee to meet to discuss the position of Clerk of the Works for the new High School.

Mr. Stutts was directed to send a letter to Mr. Williams requesting his services for an inspection of all schools for termite control.

A Special Meeting was called for September 26th to discuss and act upon the following two items:

Ice Time for the Brick Township High School Hockey team, and hiring of a teacher for the G.A.S.P program at the Brick Township High School.
