Conference The Brick Township Board of Education held a conference meeting on Tuesday, October 17, 1978 at 7:30 p.m. in the Board Office, Brick Township High School for the purpose of discussing board policy.

Present were: Mr. Schue, Mrs. Fox, Mr. Hancock and Mrs. Frake.

Also present: Mr. Stutts, Mr. Anton, Mr. Sendzik and Mr. Strauss.

Sunshine Law President Schue announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted as follows: Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, and Municipal Clerk on October 12, 1978.

Mr. Strauss was introduced by Mr. Schue. Mr. Schue stated that Mr. Strauss is to review the procedures that will be followed in preparing the new policy manual. It was suggested by Mr. Strauss and accepted by the board that Mr. Strauss will work with a committee of the board, as well as committees from the Administration.

When meetings are scheduled with Administration, members from the Board of Education will also be present.

The board directed that the contract submitted by Mr. Strass be placed on the November agenda for approval.

In addition, Mr. Stutts was directed to prepare a purchase order in the amount of \$75.00 for Mr. Strauss. This will cover the cost of five policy manuals that Mr. Strauss will codify according to the New Jersey School Boards Association numbering system, prior to the start of the review of the current policy manual.

Adjourn At 9:15 p.m. motion was made by Mr. Schue, seconded by Mrs. Frake and carried unanimously to adjourn.
