Mrs. Riley announced that the Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time, and place thereof posted as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer and Municipal Clerk on November 1, 1978.

Mr. Bunce D. Atkinson, attorney for Henry Vicaro Corporation, bidder for the General Contractor phase of the construction of the new high school, was present to discuss another company's submitted bid, and to present what they believed to be an irregularity in a low bidder's papers. The Board agreed to check out this matter, and have Mr. Anton reply to Mr. Atkinson.

Early dismissal days (time for teachers to hold parent-teacher conferences) was presented to the board by Dr. Aragona and the dates of November 20, 21, and 22 were agreed upon.

The Voucher list was discussed and Mr. Stutts presented some of Mr. Bertrand's questions to the board on various items.

At 7:54 p.m., Mrs. Frake made a motion, seconded by Mr. D'Ambola and carried unanimously to adjourn this meeting in order to begin the Regular Monthly Meeting.
