President Schue announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon. Open Public Meetings Act

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time, and place thereof posted as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Observer Courier-Sun, and Municipal Clerk on April 3, 1978.

Mr. Schue apprised the members of various pieces of correspondence he had received, one being from Mr. Lightbody with regard to blinker lights on streets near schools.

Members advised the Board Secretary which upcoming functions they expect to attend with regard to ordering necessary reservations.

At 7:45 p.m. the members began their discussion of the pre-agenda presented to them.

As each item was read, the Administrator responsible for that particular phase gave the background for the suggested motion.

It was directed that award of bids for Type II Small Vehicles be deleted from this Agenda, and Mr. Stutts was instructed to have this item rebid.

Directions were also given with regard to requests for leaves of absence, which are being held pending viewpoint of absent board members.

Need for an additional Child Study Team to work one month during the summer was given by Dr. Aragona, and the board members directed that this motion be included on the Action Agenda for April 12th.

After completing discussion of the pages of the Agenda, and directions given, other items were presented for discussion, with regard to functions to be scheduled in the near future.

Dr. Aragona stated that it is recommended that the High School Graduation be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 24, 1978.

Dr. Aragona also informed the board members that the recommended date for Promotional Exercises is Monday, June 26, 1978 with two exercises at each school, Lake Riviera Middle School and Veterans Memorial Middle School at 6:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.

A lengthy discussion followed with regard to two students, and possible action which may be taken. A meeting was scheduled for Monday, April 17, 1978 in the Board Office to meet with parents of the two students at 7:30 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as possible) to decide what action is necessary.

Mr. Stutts briefly discussed the land acquisition and U.S. Home Corporation and stated he will give the board a summary of his many meetings in this regard next week.

Mr. Schue asked Mrs. Riley to summarize her appearance, with other board members and administrators, in New York with regard to the Dunlap case.
