MICROFILM OPERATOR

DEFINITION: Under direction, prepares records of varied types for the microfilming processes and photographs them on microfilm, inspects, makes reprints and reproductions on paper; does related work required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: Receives, reviews, arranges and prepares records of varied types for the microfilming process and and sees that non-essential materials are not microfilmed; operates a camera and a film reader and sees that the necessary controls and adjustments are made to the cameras and other equipment as may be required by the nature and type of the material being filmed; checks film, using film reader and in order to insure the accuracy of the filming and to pick out defective or unsatisfactory images for retakes; assembles filmed documents which have been found to be defective or unsatisfactory; refilms these, and splices the retakes in their proper order; gives assistance to visitors who make use of the micro-filmed materials of varied types filed in the Department files; maintains a continuing record of the various microfilm projects under the supervision of the Department; performs the required reference work involved in answering inquiries concerning the microfilm; makes the required minor adjustments to the mechanical equipment and sees that it is in good working order; maintains the essential records and files; prepares progress and other reports.

1. Graduation from High School, or Vocational High School, or possession of an approved High School Equivalent Certificate, or any equivalency in education or experience, supplemented by training in the use of microfilm equipment and in approved microfilm techniques and procedures.

2. 3.
