much as he was only raising the question to protect himself under the Sunshine Law. He still feels that for protection for himself his objection be noted in the minutes. He has acquired guidelines on Open Public Meeting Law from the State which also states that a Board members objections must be noted in the minutes. Mr. Stites stated that even though he had made the motion to approve 6/29/89 meeting minutes, he would be voting against them. He read the amendment which stated "Discussion and appointment of a new Board attorney was objected to by Mr. Stites, Mr. Readell and Mrs. Benton, citing their concern over potential violations of the Open Public Meetings Law", but felt that this still did not protect his rights. He felt the minutes should accurately reflect the discussion of his objection on June 29 that the Sunshine Law had been violated. Mrs. Russell asked if a Committee should be formed to review the minutes before Board meetings. It will be discussed in the future. Mrs. Benton requested to have an insertion put in the minutes of June 29, 1989 showing the amount of money to be paid to the new Board attorney and the number of hours which this would represent.
