FINGERPRINTING

The Board of Education, being cognizant of wide spread public concern regarding kidnapping of juveniles and with knowledge that law enforcement authorities sometimes have insufficient evidence to properly identify said juveniles, shall conduct a program of fingerprinting students attending the Brick Township Schools on a voluntary basis and with the consent of the parent or legal guardian.

Students who participate in the fingerprinting program must submit a signed permission slip from his/her parent or legal guardian.

Fingerprints shall be picked up by parent(s) or guardian(s) for safe keeping. Copies shall not be retained by school authorities.

LOCKER SEARCH

The Board acknowledges its respect for the privacy of the individual pupil attending schools of this district and provides many pupils with the use of a locker in which s/he may store clothing, school materials and other personal property. Although each pupil is responsible for locking the locker assigned to him/her against incursion by others, all lockers are and shall remain the property of the Board, and in no such cases shall students have such an expectation of privacy so as to prevent examination by a school official when deemed necessary to maintain an orderly school system. The Board, however, is not responsible for any materials the student may place therein.

REGULATIONS ON CONTROL AND SEARCH OF LOCKERS

All lockers are under the jurisdiction of the Brick Township Board of Education even though assigned to individual students.
