RESOLUTION URGING FULL FUNDING OF STATE AID TO
PUBLIC EDUCATION

WHEREAS, public education is an essential element of our society which provides the foundation for the future of our state: and
WHEREAS, the New Jersey Constitution, Article VIII, 4,21, states "The Legislature shall provide for the maintenance and support of a thorough and efficient system of free public schools for the instruction of all children in the State..."; and
WHEREAS, pursuant to this Constitutional mandate, the Legislature enacted the "Public School Education Act of 1975", also known as the Thorough and Efficient (T&E) Law, N.J.S.A.18A:7A-1 et seq.; and
WHEREAS, the current funding formula established under the T & E Law provides for state aid for local school districts of approximately forty percent (40%); and
WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has refused to provide its full share of state aid by funding less than the mandated 40% in clear violation of the law; and
WHEREAS, Governor Kean and his Administration have recently urged progressive reforms in public education thereby placing education in the forefront of state and national attention; and
WHEREAS, Governor Kean shall present his 1985 Budget address to the Legislature on January 30, 1984, wherein he is expected to include a substantial surplus in said budget: now therefore be it
RESOLVED, that the Brick Township Board of Education hereby urges that Governor Kean and the Legislature provide full funding of the state aid formula for public education pursuant to law; and, be it further
RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to Governor Kean, Senate President Orechio, Assembly Speaker Karcher, the joint Appropriations Committee of the State Legislature, and to our legislative delegation.
