POLICY

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES ELIGIBILITY

Part A - Athletics

1. To be eligible for participation in inter-scholastic athletic competition during the first semester (September 1 through January 31) of the 10th grade or the second year of attendance in high school or beyond, a student must have accumulated a minimum of 25 credits during the preceding academic year.
2. To be eligible for athletic competition during the second semester (February 1 through June 30) during the ninth and subsequent grades, a student must have passed courses that are equivalent to 12½ credits or more. In determining eligibility at mid-year, a full year course for which a passing grade is earned shall count as 2½ credits. Only those courses where the student is in credit status shall be counted.

Part B - Non-Athletic Activities

The academic requirements for athletics eligibility will also pertain to non-athletic activities.

Part A

REGULATIONS

1. Annually, at the beginning of the school year, each student shall be given a copy of the academic requirements for student extracurricular activities eligibility.
2. Unsatisfactory achievement reports shall be issued at the mid-point of each marking period for those courses that a student is in danger of failing. These reports will serve as a warning notice to those students involved in athletics that loss of eligibility is imminent.
3. The high school principal shall be responsible for the enforcement of the athletic eligibility policy.
