DIRECTIVE
POLICY
#6145

On Item A an Administrative Directive for EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES ELIGIBILITY POLICY as follows:

The new Extracurricular Activities Eligibility Policy will go into effect September 1985.

Because students did not have the benefit of prior knowledge of the new, more stringent requirements contained in the policy when planning their schedules and completing their course work for the current school year, it is the administration's judgment, in fairness to the students, that a reasonable adjustment in credit requirements for first semester eligibility this coming school year be made.

Specifically, for the first semester of school year 1985-86 only, the credit requirement for eligibility will be 25 credits instead of the 30 stated in the policy.

The eligibility requirements for subsequent semesters will be enforced as written in the new policy.
