A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH DMC, INC. FOR ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH A SECTION 125 PLAN FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE TOMS RIVER REGIONAL SCHOOLS

Whereas, the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools desires to establish a cafeteria plan under the provisions of Section 125 of the Internal Revenue Code to be made available to eligible employees and

Whereas, DMC, Inc. has been found to possess the necessary administrative, enrollment and servicing capabilities for the Plan; now therefore,

☐ Be it Resolved, that DMC Inc. shall be retained by the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools for a period of one year from March 1, 1999 through February 28, 2000 to administer a Section 125 Cafeteria Plan for the Toms River Regional Schools regarding the Plan and to enroll and service those eligible employees who participate in the Plan; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools is authorized to execute an agreement, in a form to be approved by the Board of Education's Legal Department, with DMC, Inc. Based upon their proposal which stated that the Flexible Spending Account administration fee shall be an initial \$30,000 to set up with the monthly administration to be \$6 per month per participant.

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Resolution

Whereas, the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools has been requested by a number of employees to act as a paying agent for disability insurance and a pre-paid legal plan selected by such employees; and

Whereas, the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools has determined that it is in the best interests of the employees for the Payroll Department upon the request of individual employees, to deduct from the employee's gross pay such amount as the employee may designate to be paid over to the provider of disability insurance selected by the employee and to further limit the providers at this time to The Franklin, AFLAC and Legal Club of America; and

Whereas, it is understood that the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools in connection with the deduction and payment of premiums is voluntary on the part of the employee and is not to be considered to be an employment benefit and it is further understood that the Board of Education is not responsible for any portion of such premiums and participation in such plan is completely voluntary on the part of the employees. The Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools makes no representations regarding the type or adequacy of coverage or the quality of the carriers designated. All premiums are after tax dollars and the participating employees recognize that the amount deducted and paid over to the designated carrier will be included in the employees gross income reported to the Internal Revenue Service and State of New Jersey each calendar year.

Now Therefore be it Resolved, that the Board Secretary is hereby authorized upon receipt of written instructions from any Board of Education employee, to deduct and withhold from such employees' gross pay such amount as the employee may designate for the purpose of paying disability insurance premiums to The Franklin, AFLAC, and Legal Club of America the sums withheld for each respectively. The Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools shall be a paying agent only and assumes no responsibility or liability whatsoever in connection with such insurance or premiums. Payments made by the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools shall be made in accordance with the instructions of the employee and the respective carrier as to amounts, frequency of deduction and payment, and address to which payments are to be made. The specific terms of coverage, amounts of premiums and all other terms and conditions of the insurance shall be as established by separate agreement between carriers and employees.

Curriculum Committee

A Curriculum Committee Meeting of the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools took place at 1144 Hooper Avenue, on Tuesday, December 8, 1998 at 6:00 P.M.

Chairperson Garvey read the following Opening Statement:

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"Good Evening, Welcome to a Curriculum Committee Meeting of the Board of Education of the Toms River Regional Schools.

Notice of this meeting was published in the Asbury Park Press and Ocean County Observer on November 25, 1998 which constituted at least 48 hours notice as required by law under the Open Public Meetings Act."

Board Members in attendance were Linda Garvey, Chair, Meera Malik, Beverly Clayton, Richard Longo and Jamie Henninger. Guests present were Peg Bartlett, John Garrabrant, John Gluck, Pat Lewis, and Jim Mullins.

Centra State Grant for Sixth Grade Classes - ASAP - Mr. Gluck reported that Centra State Health Awareness Center has offered our district a grant to cover the cost of 500 sixth graders to attend a program, "Drugs - Choice or Chance". This program will integrate well with our "Here's Looking at You 2000" curriculum and will reinforce positive decision-making, peer pressure and the chemical changes that take place due to alcohol and drug use. The committee recommends that we accept this grant.

Special Eyes on the Environment - Mr. Gluck reviewed with the committee a proposal for selected special education students to participate in a program which allows them to explore the environment through photography. Mr. Gluck will continue to research this proposal to determine its cost to the district.

Language Arts Literacy - Mrs. Bartlett and Mrs. Lewis reviewed with the committee the status of the Language Arts Literacy Committee which has been organized to help the district align our curriculum with the Core Content Standards in language Arts Literature and to review current language arts literature programs to update our existing reading. After initial work, some members of the committee will be piloting new materials, and, hopefully, the committee will be able to make a recommendation for adoption by late spring.

Science Pilot Update - Mrs. Lewis reported on the status of the science pilots at the elementary level and explained the procedure that we have in place to procure the necessary supplies for our grade 6 program.

GO "Sites Alive" - Mrs. Bartlett and Mrs. Lewis reviewed with the committee "Sites Alive" which we are presently using in our gifted and talented classrooms. This program uses technology to link remote research sites and sailing ships with classrooms around the world. During the 1998-99 school year, the programs are Oceans Live, Rainforest Live, Class Afloat Live and Wetlands Live. We are hoping to get feedback from this year's use to determine its applicability.

AVA Review - The administration discussed with members of the committee research that they are doing on the use of audio-visual aids provided by the County AVA. They will report to us further once they have had the opportunity to analyze the data.

Game of Life - Mrs. Bartlett shared with the committee a letter she received from

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Daniel Regenye and Leslie Terjesen from the Ocean County Health Department commending Andy Peterson for the time and effort he spent in introducing The Game of Life at High School South. Because of Andy's hard work, this program has now been presented at five county high schools and the remaining schools have already been booked in the future.

State Code Proposal - Mrs. Bartlett shared with the committee the State Department of Education's Code Proposal on revised graduation requirements. This proposal has caused considerable concern around the state because its provisions would result in a significant overhaul of the system presently in place. If this code were to be adopted in its present form, all districts in the state would be required to implement a career plan for all students beginning in 5th grade.

In addition, districts must ensure that all students prior to the start of 11th grade, shall select a career major from the 14 delineated in the proposed code. Boards of Education must offer career majors through a program which combines and coordinates classroom instruction with structured learning experiences. This code, if adopted, mandates school districts to hire work-based learning coordinators to supervise, direct, or coordinate the program. All 11th and 12th grade students in the state would be required to participate in structured learning experiences for not less than one day per week. Transportation of the students to and from the work site would be the responsibility of the school district.
