Policy No. 6145
Grades 7 - 12

Part 1 - ATHLETICS

A. Grades 9 - 12

1. To be eligible for participation in interscholastic athletic competition during the first semester (September 1 through January 31) of the 10th grade or the second year of attendance in high school or beyond, a student must have accumulated a minimum of 30 credits during the preceding academic year.
2. To be eligible for athletic competition during the second semester (February 1 through June 30) during the ninth and subsequent grades, a student must have passed courses that are equivalent to 15 credits or more. In determining eligibility at mid-year, a full year course for which a passing grade is earned shall count as 2½ credits. Only those courses where the student is in credit status shall be counted.
3. A student must maintain his/her academic eligibility throughout the duration of a sports season by not failing more than one course.

B. Grades 7-8

1. A student in grades 7 and 8 must be in good academic standing to be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics. Good academic standing means having no more than one unsatisfactory grade (E) for the previous marking period.
2. A student must maintain good academic standing throughout his/her sports season.

Part 11 - NON-ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES

The academic requirements for athletic eligibility will also pertain to non-athletic activities.
