That the Board of Education adopt the Agreement of Settlement and Dismissal, Dated January 17, 1985 and January 28, 1986 inclusive of the Negotiated Agreement between the parties, for the school year 1986-1987 and 1987-1988. A release was read by Mrs. Benton as follows:

RELEASE Mr. John Martucci, President of the Brick Township Education Association, and Dr. Louis Aragona, Superintendent of Schools for the Brick Township School District, are pleased to announce the ratification of collective bargaining agreements with regard to all non-supervisory professional teaching staff members and teacher aides employed within the Brick Township School District covering the 1986-1987 and 1987-1988 academic years, and the further agreements of the parties to resolve contested litigation before the New Jersey Superior Court, Chancery Division, and the New Jersey Public Employment Relations Commission regarding a series of issues concerning the terms and conditions of employment of teaching staff members and aides employed within the Brick Township School District.

The agreement for all groups represented by the Brick Township Education Association calls for approximately an 8% raise for each year of the contract. The agreement between the Board and the Association clarifies issues such as seniority, medical

insurance, pension benefits, civil service entitlements, maternity and child rearing issues and extended sick leave request.

The parties, in recognition of the extraordinary efforts involved in concluding the above agreements, have moreover agreed to reconvene meetings between the Superintendent of Schools and representatives of the Brick Township Education Association on a regular basis to attempt to resolve any problems that relate to personnel and labor relations matters at the lowest possible level to avoid litigation. Dr. Aragona and Mr. Martucci have pledged their cooperation to insure that this new era of cooperation between the Brick Township Education Association and the Brick Township Board of Education will be a long and fruitful period wherein district administrators and Brick Township Education Association members work together with the Board of Education to insure the best possible education for district students.
