SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES PROCEDURES CONCERNING CHILDREN WITH HIV INFECTION IN GRADES K-12

On October 1, 1986, the State Board of Education unanimously adopted regulations to establish procedures for implementing the New Jersey State Department of Health Regulations which were adopted on September 10, 1986 concerning school age children with HIV infection. The Brick Township Board of Education adopts the mandatory steps and procedures issued in N.J.A.C. 8:61-1.1(j); New Jersey Administrative Code Title 6, Subtitle F, Chapter 29, Subchapter 4, 6:29-4.4; and Guidelines for Handling Body Fluids in schools.
