The Brick Township Board of Education held their Pre-Agenda Meeting beginning at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 3, 1987 in the Administration Building, 101 Hendrickson Avenue, Brick, New Jersey.

Present were: Mrs. DeConde, Mr. Laura, Mr. Readell, Mr. Stites, Mr. Roblenski, Mrs. Benton (7:34 pm) and Mr. Williamson (7:34 pm).

Also present: Mr. Wolf, Mr. Stutts and Mr. Sendzik

Mr. Stutts announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted on August 28, 1987 as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, Municipal Clerk and Brick Town News.

Motion was made by Mr. Laura, seconded by Mrs. DeConde and carried by the following roll call vote to accept the minutes of August 6, 1987, Pre-Agenda Meeting; August 13, 1987, Regular Public Meeting; and August 28, 1987, Special Meeting: Mrs. DeConde, yes; Mr. Laura, yes; Mr. Readell, yes; Mr. Stites, yes for August 13, 1987 and abstain for August 6 and 28, 1987; and Mr. Roblenski, yes.

MINUTES

Mr. Roblenski presented the Agenda. Under Curriculum and Instruction, item (a) is a request to accept funds under the provisions of P.L. 98-254 for various projects, item (b) is a Resolution to honor Mary Ann Ceres for being chosen as Ocean County Teacher-of-the-Year. Mary Ann will be present at the September 10th meeting to accept her honor. Item (c) involves a presentation which Mr. Murphy will make at the September 10th meeting regarding the Basic Skills Improvement Program.

Finance and Business items were reviewed with no discussion.

Under Personnel-Teaching, items (a thru l) were reviewed. Motion was made by Mrs. DeConde, seconded by Mr. Readell and carried unanimously by roll call vote to approve item (m) as follows:

Personnel-Non-Teaching items were presented. The only discussion was regarding item (i) to approve contracts of employment and salaries for the 1987-88 school year for two Teacher Aides; one whose salary is to be reimbursed by Toms River School District. Mrs. Benton questioned why a Teacher Aide's salary was being

Auxiliary items were presented and Mr. Williamson asked to have the Buildings and Grounds report included under item (a). It will be added for the September 10th meeting.

AUDIENCE

A member of the Drum Point PTA remarked on the exposed nails in the ceilings in one of the classrooms at Drum Point School. She was told that new insulation is going to be attached to those nails, hopefully over the Christmas break.
