LAW

Mr. Stutts announced that the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this Act, the Brick Township Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted on December 24, 1987 as follows: Board Office Bulletin Board, Asbury Park Press, Ocean County Times-Observer, Municipal Clerk and Brick Town News.

Mr. Roblenski presented the Agenda.
