Dr. Aragona stated that Administrators have been very busy interviewing and that all will be ready for the opening of school.

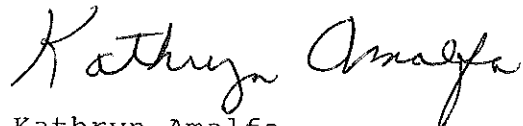
AUDIENCE
