TITLE: Supervisor of Curriculum and Instruction

SUPERVISES: Teachers

JOB GOAL: Has primary responsibility for the development, evaluation, and improvement of educational programs. Supervises the implementation and articulation of educational programs throughout the district. Assists with the supervision and evaluation of instructional personnel. Plans and implements staff development programs to develop and maintain excellence in instructional practices.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Directs the establishment and maintenance of an educational program for his/her assigned program area(s) consistent with the educational goals developed by the Board of Education.
2. Assesses student progress and the effectiveness of the educational program in assigned curricular area(s) to determine what practices or objectives to maintain or modify.
3. Supervises classroom instruction and evaluates staff in order to attain the objectives of the educational program.
4. Plans, develops, and implements programs for staff development.
5. Conducts grade level/departmental meetings on a school/district-wide basis for curriculum and/or instructional purposes.
6. Oversees the articulation of educational programs between grade levels and school units throughout the school system.
7. Identifies areas for personal professional growth, acquires appropriate skills and information, and applies them.
8. Performs such tasks and duties as may be required by his/her superordinate.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: This job description shall be consistent with the terms and conditions of employment as set forth in the agreement between the Brick Township Board of Education and the Brick Township Association of School Administrators.

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with provision of the Board's policy on Evaluation of Professional Personnel.
