

PERSONNEL (Teaching)

Dr. Aragona reviewed Personnel-Teaching items. Much discussion ensued regarding the proposed hiring of two athletic trainers. Some Board Members felt that they should not be hired until a job description for that position was established. Mr. Wolf explained that the people being considered had offers from other districts and had been interviewed at length by our two Athletic Directors and were aware of what their duties would be and he felt it was not fair to make them wait. After much discussion, it was decided to table this issue.

Motion was made by Mr. Pannucci, seconded by Mr. Leahy and carried unanimously by roll call vote to table item (f) under Personnel-Teaching (hiring of two athletic trainers) until a proper job description was ready. After more discussion it was felt that the motion should be amended to show a time limit.

Motion was made by Mrs. Benton, seconded by Mr. Pannucci and carried by the following roll call vote to amend the previous motion to reintroduce item (f) on the January agenda with all completed information ready for the Board: Mrs. Benton, yes; Mr. Pannucci, yes; Mr. Leahy, no; and Mrs. Russell, yes.

Motion was made by Mrs. Benton, seconded by Mr. Pannucci to approve items (a-i) under Personnel-Teaching, with the exception of item (f) which was tabled, with the following results: Mrs. Benton, yes; Mr. Pannucci, yes; Mr. Leahy, yes on all but item (h) with no reflection on the person involved, just his feeling that the position is not needed; and Mrs. Russell, yes. Motion did not carry as a majority of all Board Members must vote yes on hiring of teaching staff. When Mr. Leahy realized that his "no" vote would mean that the individual in item (h) would not be hired and that Lake Riviera Middle School would then be without any Assistant Principal, he asked to reverse his "no" vote, with the understanding that he does not feel that two Assistant Principals are necessary.

Motion was then made by Mrs. Benton, seconded by Mr. Pannucci and carried unanimously by roll call vote to approve item (h) under Personnel-Teaching as listed on page 4a on the Agenda.
